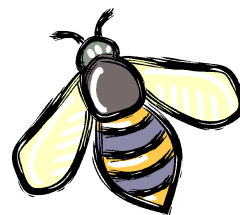

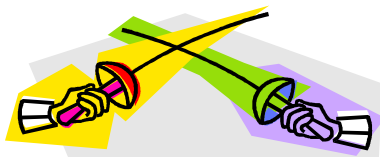

Deadline is February 15 for Hardship Transfer Applications

Applications are available for parents who wish to apply for a 2012-2013 hardship transfer or to renew a current hardship to another Fulton elementary, middle or high school. Please logon the "Parents" section of the school system's web site, to enter information and then print it to obtain signatures and/or supporting documentation. Although using the online form will help expedite processing time, printed applications may also be picked up at all schools as well as the Fulton County Schools Administration Building. The deadline for submitting a transfer application is **February 15, 2012 by 4:30 p.m.**, with no exceptions or extensions granted. All requests must be received or postmarked by this date and time. Applications can be sent by mail, fax or hand-delivered to: Fulton County Schools' Student Assignment Office, c/o Meadows Operation Center, 5270 Northfield Blvd. College Park, GA. 30349. The fax number is 404-763-5546. The February 15 deadline applies to students and parents seeking a hardship transfer for medical reasons, curriculum differences, child-care situations or for employees' children. Schools participating in open enrollment, a separate transfer process that allows students to move to a school with available space, will be announced in early May.
