Expected enrollment for 2010-2011 and impact:

- Math Curriculum changes will be made.
- Budget cuts will continue to be made.
- Each Fulton County employ should have 6 furlough days total for 2009-2010 school year. Additional furloughs are being recommended for the 2010-2011 school year.
- In 2010-2011 school year, class sizes will increase to K to 22 students, 1st through 3rd to 23 students, 4th through 5th to 30 students.

FCSS Budget status and possible impact to RNE:

- It was suggested that PTA/parent volunteers help teachers during pre-planning to help with furlough days.
- Are there other things we can change within the schools to save money and energy? Example: turning off all lights at night, using less water flow in restroom areas.

- In the 2010-2011 school year, Fulton County is looking to cut an additional \$40 million.
