LSAC committee meeting

Meeting began at 3:04.

Reading and Approval of Minutes:

- February 8<sup>th</sup> minutes were approved by all members.

Budget Update:

- Money from the general budget was again allocated for copy paper, teacher supply money, media center funds, etc...
- Not sure if we will be able to hire back our part time EIP teacher and our SST chairperson. SST chairperson could be replaced by the counselor, CST, or Assistant Principal if funded is not provided. Boosterthon money could potentially be allocated towards these cuts.

Teacher Allocations:

- RIF's affected our Preschool teachers due to salary cuts from the state level and a 1<sup>st</sup> grade teacher.
  - One Kindergarten teacher is retiring, two 1<sup>st</sup> grade teachers are leaving, three 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teachers are retiring, and one 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher is retiring.
  - Special Education teachers will remain in their positions.

CRCT remediation:

- CRCT scores are in but we do not know how many students will need remediation yet. Students will be remediated the rest of the school year and will retake the test during Postplanning.

Principal Selection:

- Principal interviews will be done May 18<sup>th</sup> for the next principal of RNE. Parents and teachers had an opportunity to fill out surveys about what they would prefer to see in the next principal. Principal interviews will be done by a committee of people consisting of Lisa Walker (PTA co-president), Inge Robb (LSAC chair), Suzie Consoer (teacher), Ted Ittig (teacher), Cali Roju (local principal), the Deputy

Superintendent, the new area Superintendent and a representative from Human Resources.

Projected Strategic Plan:

- 2009-2010- increase Math and writing scores, increase scores for the Special Education population
- 2010-2011- will continue to increase Math scores, more will be decided after further review of the CRCT scores and discussion with grade levels.

Discussion:

- Two new teacher representatives will be appointed to LSAC for next year since Ted Ittig and Aubrey Conner have served their two year commitment to LSAC.
