

# GED<sup>®</sup> REGISTRATION

**WHO:** The GED Tests can be administered only to persons who:

- Have not graduated from an accredited high school or received a high school equivalency certificate or diploma;
- Are not currently enrolled in a regular high school;
- Are at least 16 years of age (candidates who are under age 18 must receive approval from GEDTS-Georgia)

**WHEN:** As Outlined in the GED Testing Schedule

**HOW:** Registration Requirements:

- A Valid State Picture ID.
- Under-age youth (16 and 17 years old) must be accompanied by a parent or a guardian to register, or request a parental consent form. The under-age candidate should also meet the requirements as outlined below.
- A school withdrawal form is also required for all persons under 19 years of age.

## **Underage Process**

**(Fulton County GED® Testing Center)**

**The State of Georgia allows 16 and 17 year olds to take the GED test with the approval of the State GED Administrator. This process will begin, at the GED testing office, at the time of the initial appointment with the GED Examiner. All candidates 16 or 17 years of age must first attend GED Classes and fulfill all requirements as established by the GED National Offices in Washington DC. Once students meet the classroom requirements (Individuals must complete a minimum of 12 classroom hours of instruction and score a minimum overall average standard score of 500 points on the official GED practice test or score 80% on other approved assessments. Recommendation for testing is confirmed, in writing, by the GED Instructor) the GED Instructor will send the completed Under Age Request Form (Attention: Peter Gaddis) to the Fulton County GED testing office. We will then submit the request to the State Administrator; the student will receive a copy of approval upon request. Underage applicants must also complete an underage application and demographic form. If a candidate has already received special needs-underage approval with another testing center it can be verified in PASSPORT.**
