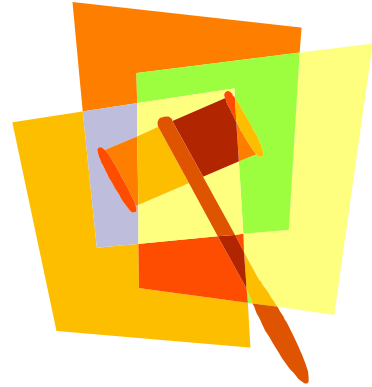


DUE PROCESS



The Fulton County Board of Education adheres to due process laws as guaranteed by the United States Constitution. The FCBOE Code of Conduct is divided into two sections. The first covers the **SUBSTANTIVE DUE PROCESS RIGHTS**, and the second portion indicates the **PROCEDURAL DUE PROCESS RIGHTS** provided to students in the school district.

Substantive Due Process rights are those which protect a student's right to an education. The essence of substantive due process is protection from arbitrary and unreasonable action.

Procedural Due Process rights are those which guarantee fair procedures. Reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard and present a defense are embodied in the process.
