### **North Springs High Student Named Finalist for Women in Technology ‘Girl of the Year’ Award**

**Three Fulton students nominated for the award to be announced on November 16**

Three Fulton County students are among nine honorees for the 2017 Women in Technology (WIT) **Girl of the Year** award; and North Springs Charter High 11th-grader **Elaine Wen** has emerged as a finalist for the top honor.

Girl of the Year recognizes a student who has demonstrated a strong interest in science, technology, engineering or math and exemplary performance in education and school citizenship. Honorees also are required to be fully engaged in one or more WIT GIRLS programs for one year.
