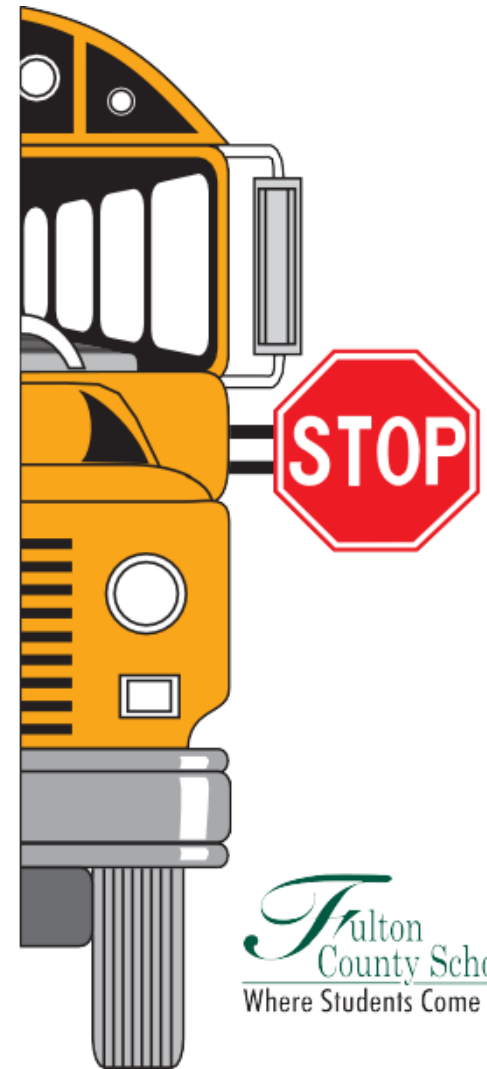

Our Mission: To deliver students safely to their destinations on-time and in a frame of mind ready to learn.

Each day Fulton County school buses transport our students to over 100 schools while traveling over 50,000 miles on every major thoroughfare going through Fulton County. Our Transportation Department strives to remain the safest form of transportation to and from school, while continuing to exceed your expectations of on-time delivery.

Fulton County School's Goal: Our goal is to prepare all students to graduate ready to pursue and succeed on their chosen paths. To support this goal, we will focus deeply on student achievement, people and culture, community collaboration, and fiscal responsibility.

Transportation's Initiatives To "Deliver" The Goal:

Student Achievement

"Increase the % of students reading at or above grade level in 3rd grade."

Transportation will have a soft launch with one elementary school in each Learning Community. The bus will become a true extension of the classroom by using "magnetic sign" sight words on the bus. These sight words will allow our school bus drivers to interact with their students to increase the % of students reading at or above grade level.

People and Culture

"We provide a welcoming environment...for students, families, and employees."

Transportation has integrated a "Moments that Matter" frame-of-reference for all of our employees. We will greet each of our customers with a smile and a welcoming heart and provide a safe bus ride to and from schools.

Community Collaboration

"We engage families, community members, and civic organizations as active partners."

Transportation has built strong municipal partnerships. These partnerships are proven to be invaluable during inclement weather and other emergencies. Our municipal partners have provided us with immediate contact numbers to call and receive up-to-the minute information.

As Transportation replaces school buses we are adding three-point safety belts on all of our buses. The School Board has approved "wearing seat belts" in Board policy. We ask that parents remind your children to "buckle-up!"

Fiscal Responsibility

"...ensure that resources are used effectively and efficiently to impact district goals."

Transportation has applied for and received over 2.4 million dollars in EPA Grant Funding since 2016. This funding has allowed FCS Transportation to purchase, by the beginning of school year 18-19, over 190 propane powered school buses. Propane fuel costs, along with very low maintenance costs allows our Department to put money back into the classroom.
