Fulton County Schools to hold Topping Out celebration for new North Maintenance facility

What: Fulton County Schools is celebrating a milestone in the construction of the district's new North Maintenance facility with a Topping Out celebration.

Historically, a "Topping Out" is when the last beam is placed on top of a structure or the final roofing piece is placed. In some buildings, a pine tree is installed or an American flag is flown near the top of the structure.

The building's contractor, R.K. Redding Construction, is providing a BBQ lunch for the construction crews, North Maintenance employees, and special guests.

The 34,000-square-foot replacement facility is funded by the one-penny education sales tax, SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax). The sales tax is funding new construction, additions and renovations, technology innovations, transportation upgrades and safety improvements. A similar facility is under construction in Fairburn to serve the South Fulton community.
