

Project Registration Information

Your student would like to represent his/her school by participating in the Fulton County Technology Competition to be held on **January 30, 2010 at Westlake High School**.

The Technology Competition is open to home school, private, and public school students in grades 3 – 12 residing in Fulton County. First place winners in the Fulton County Competition are eligible to participate in the GaETC State Technology Fair to be held on March 13, 2010 at Howard High School, Macon, GA. This is a great opportunity for your student to share his/her knowledge with peers, teachers, and others. Staffed by volunteers, the 9th Annual competition is a one-day format.

Check-In Information

Please be sure to check-in on time! All students in grade levels 3 through 6 must be checked in by 8 a.m. All students in grade levels 7 through 12 must be checked in by 1:15 p.m. with the exception of students in the Individual Programming Challenge. Participants in the Individual Programming Challenge (grades 7 – 12 only) will have a change in check-in and competition time. Students in this category will check in between 9 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. and begin work on their project immediately after check-in closes.

No students will be checked in after the times designated for their division.

1. A student may enter **only one project** either individually **or** as a member of a team (maximum of 2 members per team) in the following competition categories:

2. All students must be registered by **January 15, 2010 at 4 PM**. Students must return a Registration/Parent Consent form (see below) with parent signature to be eligible to enter the Competition. To ensure that all students are registered before the deadline, the signed Registration/Parent Consent form must be returned to the school liaison no later than January 11, 2010. A list of school liaisons is available under the Resources link on the Competition website. Students register in their current grade level. Students entering as a team must compete at the grade level of the oldest member of the team. Teams are made up of **no more than two members**. Each member of the team must turn in an individual Registration/Parent Consent form. **If a student participates as a team member, he/she may not enter an individual project.**
3. For individual projects, the student **must** be present for judging on the day of the competition. Team projects must be represented by at least one member of the team.

Parents will be responsible for the following:

1. An adult must be named who will be responsible for onsite student supervision during the Competition. This may be a parent, teacher, or other responsible adult. This is required for elementary and middle school students.
