

FULTON TECHNOLOGY COMPETITION

Your child has been chosen to represent our school by participating in the Fulton County Technology Competition to be held on Saturday, **January 28 at Riverwood International Charter School**. The Technology Competition is open to Fulton County School students in grades 3 – 12. First place winners in our Competition are eligible to compete in the GaETC State Technology Fair to be held in March. This is a great opportunity for your student to share his/her knowledge with peers, teachers, and others.

Students will present their project for judging on **Saturday, January 28, 2012**. Students will receive a judging appointment time. Students must check in at least 30 minutes before their appointment times and will be given 15 minutes to set up the project before judging begins. Our judges are on a strict time schedule and each project must be judged at the assigned time.

There will be no changing or trading of times after the appointments have been set. There will be absolutely no trading of times on the day of the competition. The times have been arranged to consider all the projects in each category, the room placement, grade level groupings, and the awards ceremony.

Parents will be responsible for the following:

1. An adult must be named who will be responsible for onsite student supervision during the Competition. This can be a parent, teacher or other responsible adult. This is required for elementary and middle school students.
2. Arrange for the student's transportation to and from the Competition.
3. Review the detailed information on the website with the student to ensure the student is aware of the rules of the Technology Competition. The website is accessible through Fulton County school computers and library computers.
