Georgia Kindergarten Assessment Program (GKAP)	Kindergarten
Criterion Referenced Competency Tests (CRCT)	Grades 1-8
State of Georgia Elementary Writing Assessment	Grades 3-5
Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS)	Grades 3 and 5
State of Georgia Middle School Writing Assessment	Grade 8
Checkpoints	Grades 2-8 Grades 9 and 11
State of Georgia End of Course Tests (EOCT)	In English/language arts students are tested at the completion of literature and composition courses in grades 9 and 11
Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Tests (PSAT)	All Fulton students in grades 9-11 take the PSAT, during the school day, free of charge.
Georgia High School Graduation Test (GHS GT)	11 th Grade students take the Writing portion of the GHS GT in the fall and the multiple-choice Language Arts portion in the spring.

Optional Assessments

Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)	Devised and administered by the College Board, the SAT is generally taken by 11 th and 12 th grade students.
(ACT)	Generally taken by 11 th and 12 th grade students. As with the SAT, scores are used for college admission
Advanced Placement (AP) Exams	Students enrolled in AP courses take the assessment in Literature and Composition and Language and Composition. The assessments are administered by the College Board each year in May.
International Baccalaureate (IB)	IB Diploma Candidate Program students take examinations in various academic disciplines at required intervals.
