Enrollments are on a walk-in basis and will take place in the Centennial Media Center. To ensure that your registration goes smoothly, it is critical that you provide all of the required documents at the time of enrollment. Please refer to the reverse side for a complete list of required documents. After August 13th, enrollments will require an appointment, which should be scheduled with Centennial's counseling office.

CENTENNIAL HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELING OFFICE

The following documents MUST be provided to enroll a student:

- Copy of student's final transcript
 - *Students recommended for Honors or AP classes must provide a letter indicating such from the previous school*
- Attendance records from previous school
- Discipline records from previous school
- Complete mailing address of previous school
- Copy of student's social security card
- Copy of student's birth certificate
- TWO verifications of residency
 - *A house contract/lease, utility bill, pay stub, etc (must be current within 30 days)*
- Picture ID of parent/legal guardian
- Currently updated Immunization Certificate (Form #3231 only)
- Ear, Eye, Dental Certificate (Form #3300)
 - *Georgia State Law requires these to be on a State of Georgia form, available from student's doctor or at the North Fulton Regional Health Center located at 3155 Royal Drive, Alpharetta, GA (404-332-1958)*
- Proof of custody
 - *Probate Court can provide information for those that are not the biological parent seeking guardianship (404-430-4693)...ONLY the natural parent or legal guardian may enroll a student*
- A current Individual Education Plan (IEP) for a student with special needs must be provided

** Students transferring within Fulton County need only provide 2 proofs of residency and a picture ID; all other documents will be obtained from current Fulton County file.*

NO STUDENT WILL BE ENROLLED WITHOUT PROVIDING ALL OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BEFORE OR AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION

The student MUST come with a parent or legal guardian to register for classes.

It is the responsibility of the parent/legal guardian to obtain all necessary documents from the previous school.
