Strict adherence to the following final exam guidelines is expected. Any exceptions require the approval of an administrator.

Spring Semester Examinations shall be a minimum of one and one-half hours long and a maximum of two hours. All credit courses offered at Centennial High School will have final examinations with the exception of courses for which the EOCT is administered. In these courses a gradable experience will be given. Exams will be written. Oral presentations, mock trials, etc. are not to be considered final exams. All students are to remain in the examination room until the conclusion of the examination period.

No semester final examinations will be administered early to students. Please do not submit any such requests as they will not be honored.

No examination at Centennial High School shall have a value of less than 15 % or more than 25% of the final grade for the course.

Parent questions regarding course semester final examinations should be directed to the teacher of the course.

Lunches offered to students at Centennial High School will take place after the examinations are completed.

Bus transportation will be available beginning at 1:00 pm. M-to-M transportation will be available for students at approximately 1:10 PM

Each teacher should either check or collect all textbooks on the day of the examination. Even if a student has not met all of his/her obligations for returning textbooks or made restitution for the textbooks, he/she should be administered a final examination. If you are not familiar with process for making restitution for lost books, see Ms. Littman in the AP office.

Students will not be allowed to check out early during examination periods. Students must remain in the classroom during examinations. Students should use the rest rooms prior to examinations and should request rest room access during the examination only in serious need.
