While becoming **resilient** is a personal journey for each child, it *can be* learned. Adolescents often experience difficulty keeping problems or hardships in perspective. Haynes Bridge faculty and staff spent a portion of the September Early Release Day discovering how implementing strategies that build resiliency in middle school can be effective in breaking through the barriers to achievement for many students. Join HBMS Graduation Coach, Jennifer Wilson, for a discussion on how **resilience** can be taught in school and home to help children deal with day-to-day stressors and think more realistically and flexibly about the problems they encounter.

Student Agenda

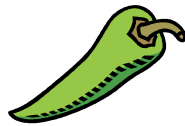
