There are forms in the back to review and sign for return, however, the book stays home with the parent. Students have the same information in their Student Agenda. The agenda stays with the student at all times.

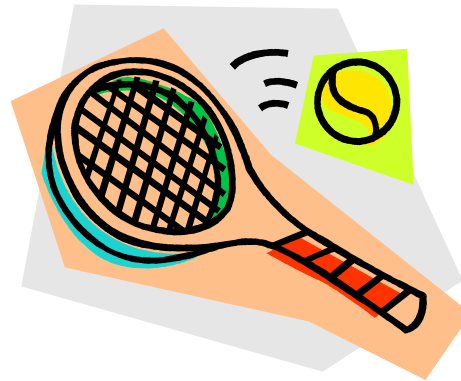
