are welcome to stop by anytime as long as they have a pass from their teacher. Parents and community are invited and encouraged to stop by and shop the book fair.



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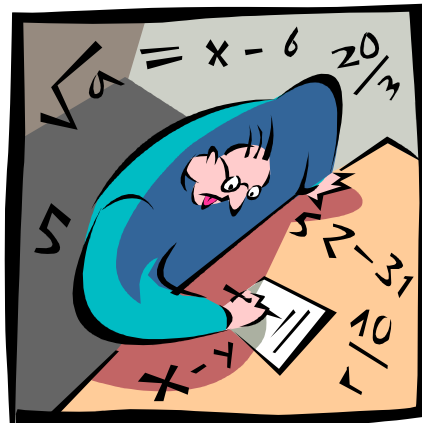
