

# Health Registration Requirements for the State of Georgia

## Ear, Eye and Dental Screening

No child entering a Georgia school for the first time shall be admitted unless the child has a certificate of eye, ear and dental screening. This Georgia Department of Human Resources certificate (Form 3300) must be signed by the Health Department or a licensed Georgia physician.

## Immunization certificate

Georgia requires students to be immunized against measles, mumps, polio, rubella, whooping cough, tetanus, diphtheria, hepatitis B, hepatitis A, haemophilus influenza, and varicella. Immunization information must be on the proper Georgia Department of Human Resources form; these are available through the Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness or local physicians (Form 3231). Sixth grade students must have an additional MMR (mumps, measles and rubella) vaccine and are required to have (2) chicken pox (varicella) vaccines or proof of immunity. Form 3231 must be signed by the Health Department or a licensed Georgia physician.

## Information for Getting Shots

1. Take your child and his/her shot record with you when you go to get a certificate. More shots may be needed.
2. A doctor or health official where the shots were originally given can replace a lost immunization certificate.
3. Out-of-State immunization certificates **MUST** be changed to a Georgia certificate by a Georgia doctor or health official.
4. Shots may need to be taken again if the original records cannot be located.
5. Students must be present for the Eye, Ear and Dental examination.
6. Call and check local health center's hours and availability of appointments.

Students registering from out-of-state have 30 days to obtain a Georgia immunization certificate and 120 days to obtain a Georgia Eye, Ear and Dental certificate. If either of these forms is not filed in a timely manner the student will be withdrawn from school until said forms are obtained.
