- **HOW DOES IT WORK FOR STUDENTS?**

Each student has their own online account and takes a questionnaire that finds their interests, learning styles, and expression styles. The program then matches online resources to each child so that kids have their own mini-internet with safe, educational resources.

- **HOW DOES IT WORK FOR TEACHERS?**

Teachers use Renzulli to discover your child's learning styles, to quickly find dynamic websites for class, to group students based on their strengths, and to provide real world applications. They can send students work online and receive work back online.

- **DOES THE PROGRAM WORK OUT OF SCHOOL?**

Yes! Students can use their Renzulli account anywhere you connect to the internet.

- **HOW DOES IT WORK FOR PARENTS?**

Parents can create their own account to: view their child's academic profile, look at their work, check out websites they've visited and their login history, access their assignments, projects and online journal, send them a message, and more!
