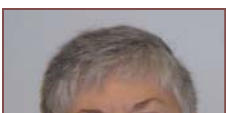
SOCIAL STUDIES DEPARTMENT

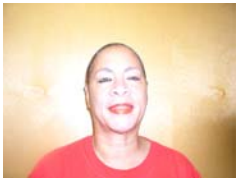
