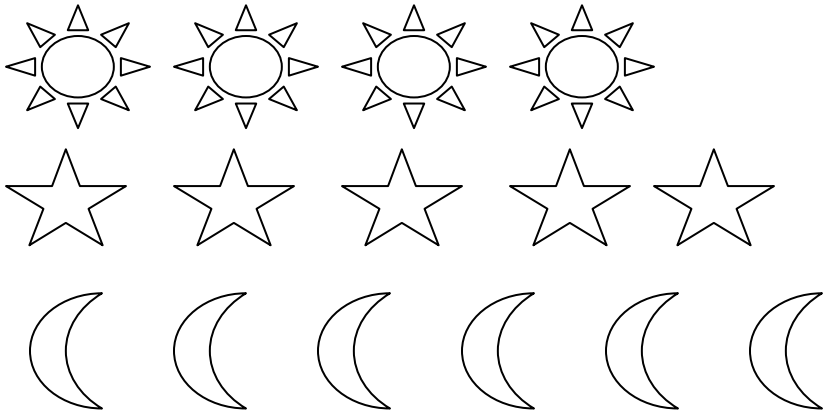

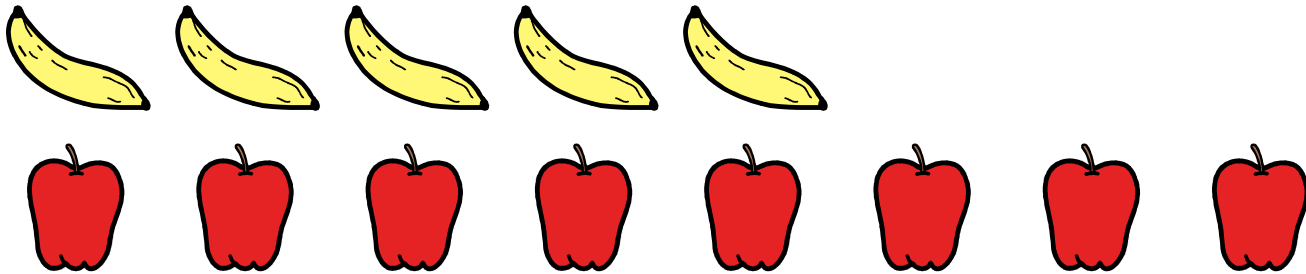
Kindergarten: How many stars are there?
