2010-2011 Participation Fee

The participation fee is an annual contribution from all parents/guardians of students participating in the Johns Creek High School Orchestra. Participation fees cover multiple expenses incurred by the orchestra during the school year, including activity fees (such as festivals and special performances), cost of clinicians (for specialized workshops), program expenses (such as sheet music and recordings), maintenance expenses (such as piano tuning), awards (such as the orchestra banquet), and miscellaneous expenses (such as reception refreshments).

Orchestra students have the opportunity to earn money through fundraising events. Their earnings go into their Individual Student Accounts. Individual Student Account funds may be used by orchestra students to meet future participation fee obligations or for educational activities fees as designated by the Orchestra Director.

Fulton County does not provide the funds necessary to cover the expenses listed above. Your participation fee has a direct impact on the quality of the Orchestra Program and on the quality of music education students will receive.
