## Science Olympiad Team

The Northview Science Olympiad Team consists of students in grades 9-12 who aren't afraid to learn something new or dedicate some spare time to practicing events. This past year our team won 1<sup>st</sup> place at the regional tournament and 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the state tournament. We hope to qualify for the national tournament this year! New members are always welcomed!

The team offers students interested in a range of science, communications, and engineering subjects a chance to test their skills, knowledge and quick minds against fellow Olympians. And while medals and certificates are bestowed annually upon the team, any member will tell you that nothing beats the thrill of a device that works without a hitch!

A Science Olympiad team consists of up to 15 students. Our school will have three teams compete in the regional tournament. No more than seven students can be from the twelfth grade on any team. Most events allow for at least two team members. Events are scheduled over a 5 or 6 hour period; consequently many students will be able to compete in 3-6 different events.

- **Regional C Division will be either:**
  - February 16, 2008: Emory University (Atlanta); *or*
  - February 23, 2008 at Southern Polytechnic Institute (Marietta)
- **State C Division will be** March 29, 2008 at Augusta State University (Augusta)
- **National C Division will be** May 30 - 31, 2008 at The George Washington University (Washington DC)
- We also may be able to send one team to the **National Invitational Tournament** at George Washington University on January 26, 2008
- Westminster often hosts an invitational tournament sometime in November. The date will be announced as soon as possible.

### Cost

To participate on the Science Olympiad Team, a fee of \$30.00 is required to cover cost of materials, equipment and tournament costs. In addition, any student who participates in off campus, school sponsored activities **must have medical insurance**. This can be a private policy or insurance purchased through the school, a.k.a. school insurance. **Additional costs may be required for travel should a team move on to state or national level competition.**
