

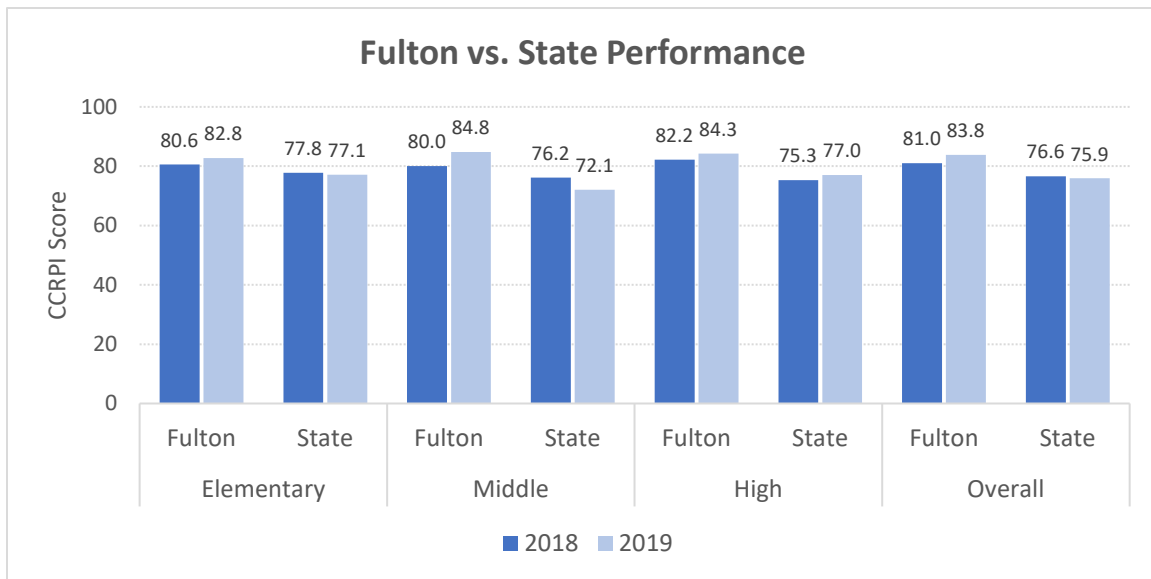
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2019 College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) Results

Fulton County saw increases in scores for the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) across the district for School Year 2018-2019. The overall score for the district was 83.8, a 2.8 point increase over the 2018 score of 81.0. Scores for each level also increased as follows:

While Fulton County Schools' scores increased, the overall state performance dropped to 75.9. This widened the gap between the district performance and the state performance by 3.5 points, from 4.4 points in 2018 to 7.9 points in 2019. A summary of performance in Fulton County Schools compared to the state is shown below.



At the school level, a total of 67 schools increased their 2019 scores compared to 2018 scores. Nineteen (19) schools had double-digit gains in the CCRPI score for 2019. Those schools are:
