

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2019 SAT Results

Performance on SAT exams by the 2019 graduating class dropped slightly for Fulton with an average Total Score for Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math of 1086, down from 1091 in 2018. The number of test takers increased from 5,411 in 2018 to 5,430 in 2019. The percent of graduates participating in the SAT dipped from 78.7 percent in 2018 to 77.1 percent in 2019.

The current version of the SAT was first administered in March 2016 and includes two sections – Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math. Each section has a possible score of 800 making the possible total score for the assessment 1600.

Performance on college and career readiness benchmarks for 2019 was essentially level with 2018. The college and career readiness benchmarks represent a 75 percent likelihood of a student achieving at a grade of C in a first-semester, credit-bearing college course in a related subject. Performance for students meeting both benchmarks for Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math remained at 50 percent. Individually, the percent of students meeting the Evidence-Based Reading/Writing benchmark was 72 percent, a slight decrease from 2018. Performance for students meeting the Math benchmark was equal to 2018 at 51 percent.

Seven schools increased results over the prior year: Cambridge HS (+1); Independence HS (+39); Milton HS (+5); Northview HS (+15); Riverwood International Charter HS (+19); Roswell (+7), and Westlake HS (+7). The full list of results for all schools is shown below:
