## Executive Summary

### Georgia Department of Education Releases the 2023 CSI, TSI, and ATSI Lists

---

On January 9, 2024, the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) released the Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI), Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) federal school identification lists based on school year (SY) 2023.

CSI identifies the lowest performing 5% of all Title I schools, all high schools with a graduation rate of less than 67%, and all schools identified for ATSI support for the same student group(s) for six (6) consecutive years. CSI schools are identified every three (3) years by GaDOE. TSI identifies any school with one or more consistently underperforming student groups. GaDOE will identify TSI schools annually. Among schools meeting the TSI criteria, ATSI identifies any school in which any student group, on its own, would be identified as a CSI school. GaDOE will identify ATSI schools every three years.

The 2023 lists included five (5) traditional schools in the Fulton County Schools (FCS) district. The state identified Conley Hills Elementary School as a CSI lowest performance due to its performance within the lowest 5% of schools. Fulton Academy of Virtual Excellence (high school) was placed on the CSI graduation list because its graduation rate was below the 67% threshold. The ATSI list includes Brookview and Seaborn Lee elementary schools, and Banneker High School due to the performance of the Students with Disabilities (SWD) subgroup.

FCS had five (5) traditional schools identified for 2022 lists. Four (4) of the five (5) traditional schools earned removal from the list by demonstrating improvement in 2023. One school, College Park Elementary School, is not eligible for removal for two additional school years due to its designation as a Tier IV school. Three charter schools, Hapeville Charter Middle School, RISE Grammar and RISE Prep were identified as TSI in 2022. Hapeville Charter closed after the 2022 school year and Rise Grammar and Prep were closed after the 2023 school year.
