Course Description:

Introduction to Software Technology is the foundational course for the Web & Digital Design and the Computer Science pathways. This course is designed for students to understand, communicate, and adapt to a digital world as it impacts their personal life, society, and the business world.

Adobe Creative Cloud, HTML, CSS and JavaScript will be highlighted to expose students to the emerging technologies impacting the digital world. Employability skills are integrated into activities, tasks, and projects throughout the course standards to demonstrate the skills required by business and industry.

- Individuals considering this course should be self-motivated and dedicated to improving their knowledge and skills as they relate to digital technology.
- Individuals enrolled in Intro to Software Technology should understand that this course is for 1 (one) high school credit.
- Assignments, projects and assessments will be of equal rigor to the high school curriculum. There will be homework and strict deadlines for all assignments.
- Students will be expected to complete the full course once they are enrolled in the Intro to Software Technology class; no student will be able to drop the class once enrolled. (*Exceptions will be made for extenuating circumstances*).
- Upon successful completion of the course, students will earn high school credit.
- Web & Digital Design and Computer Science pathways are offered at Chattahoochee High School.
