Frequently Asked Questions

The Fulton County Schools Annual Perception Survey is an important tool for stakeholders (students, staff, and parents/guardians) to provide feedback to FCS. This process offers various perspectives on key issues and allows the voices of different groups to be heard.

When can I take the survey?

The survey will be open from Monday, February 13th at 8:00 AM through Friday, March 10th at 11:59 PM.

Is the survey anonymous?

All survey responses are anonymous and confidential.

How can I take the survey?

The survey is being administered digitally. You can complete the survey using any device; computer, smartphone, tablet, etc. You can use this link to access the survey: <https://tinyurl.com/FCSSurvey-Parents>

Will the survey be available in multiple languages?

Yes. The survey will be available in the following languages: English, Spanish, Chinese (Simplified), Korean, and Hindi.

How long will it take to fill out the survey?

The survey should take about 10-20 minutes to complete.

What should I do if I have students in multiple schools?

It is important to gather parent/guardian feedback. A parent/guardian should fill out one survey for each school in which they have a child attend in the district. We request that each parent/guardian of a student fill out the survey.

How will Fulton County use results from the survey?

Fulton County Schools values feedback from our stakeholders. After administration, the district will publish summarized reports. We will analyze the data for emerging themes on strengths and areas for growth. This will eventually be incorporated into the district's Balanced Scorecard.
