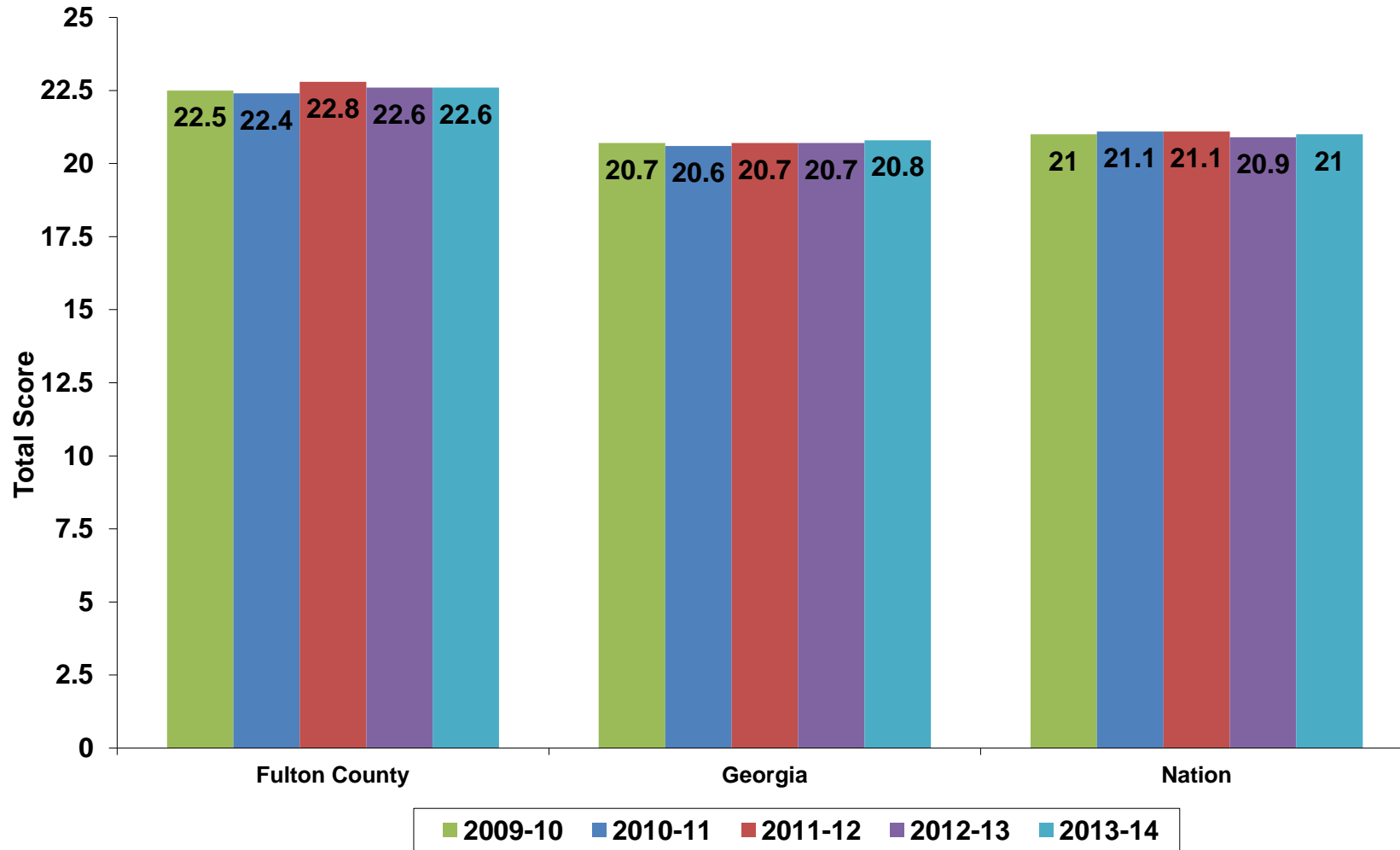
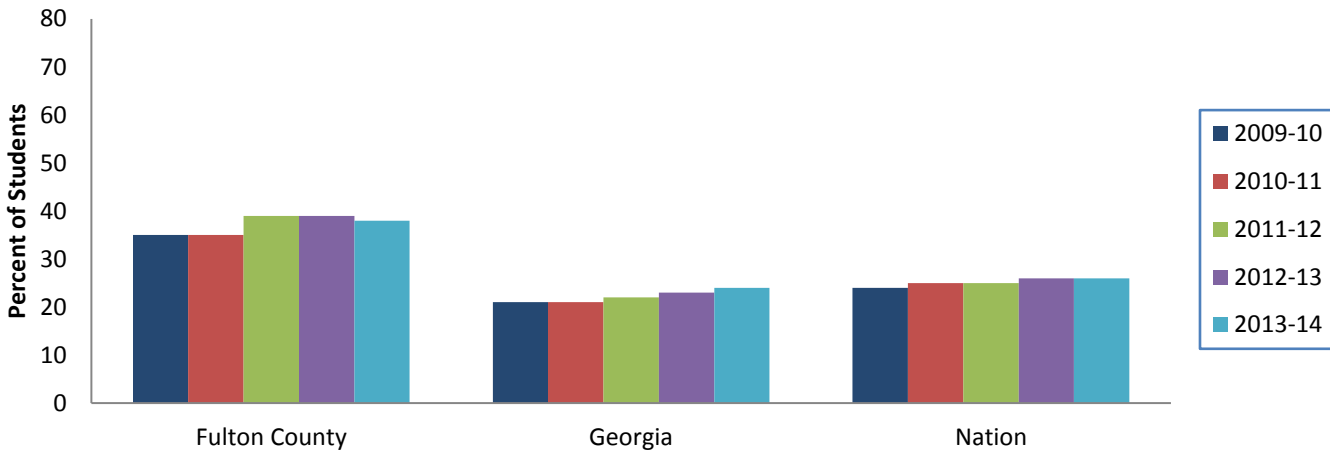


## Fulton County Five Year Comparison Composite ACT Scores

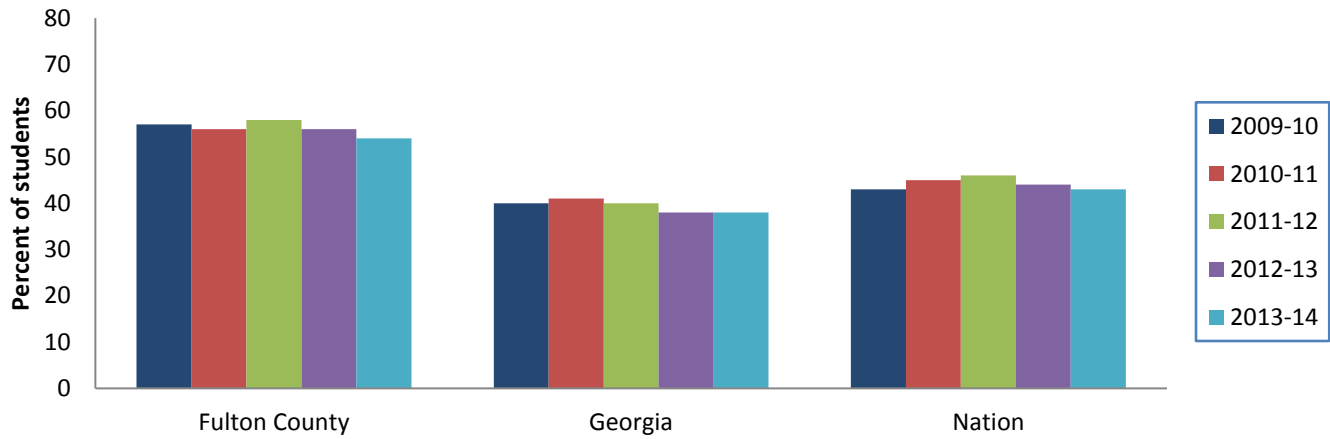

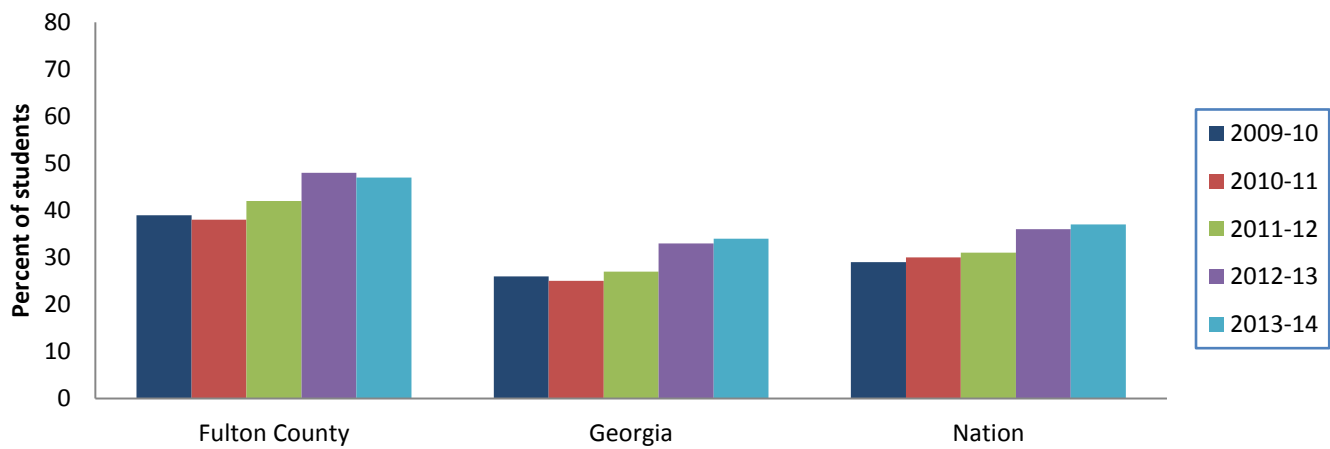
## Percent Meeting All Four Benchmarks



## Percent Meeting Mathematics Benchmark

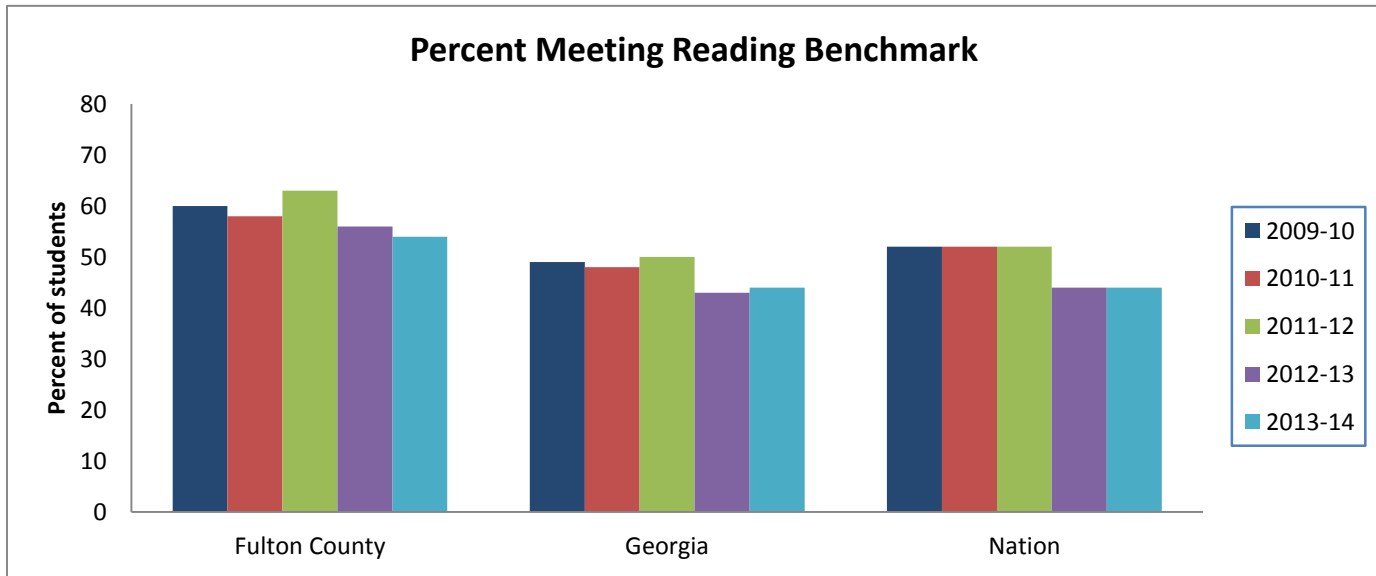
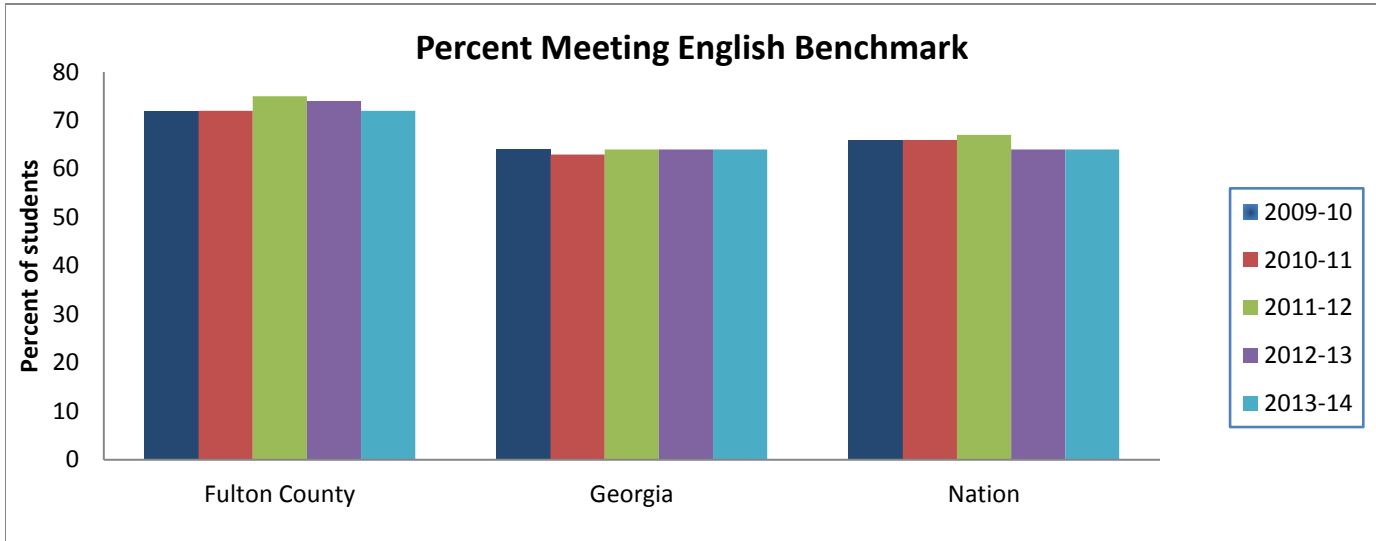


## Percent Meeting Science Benchmark

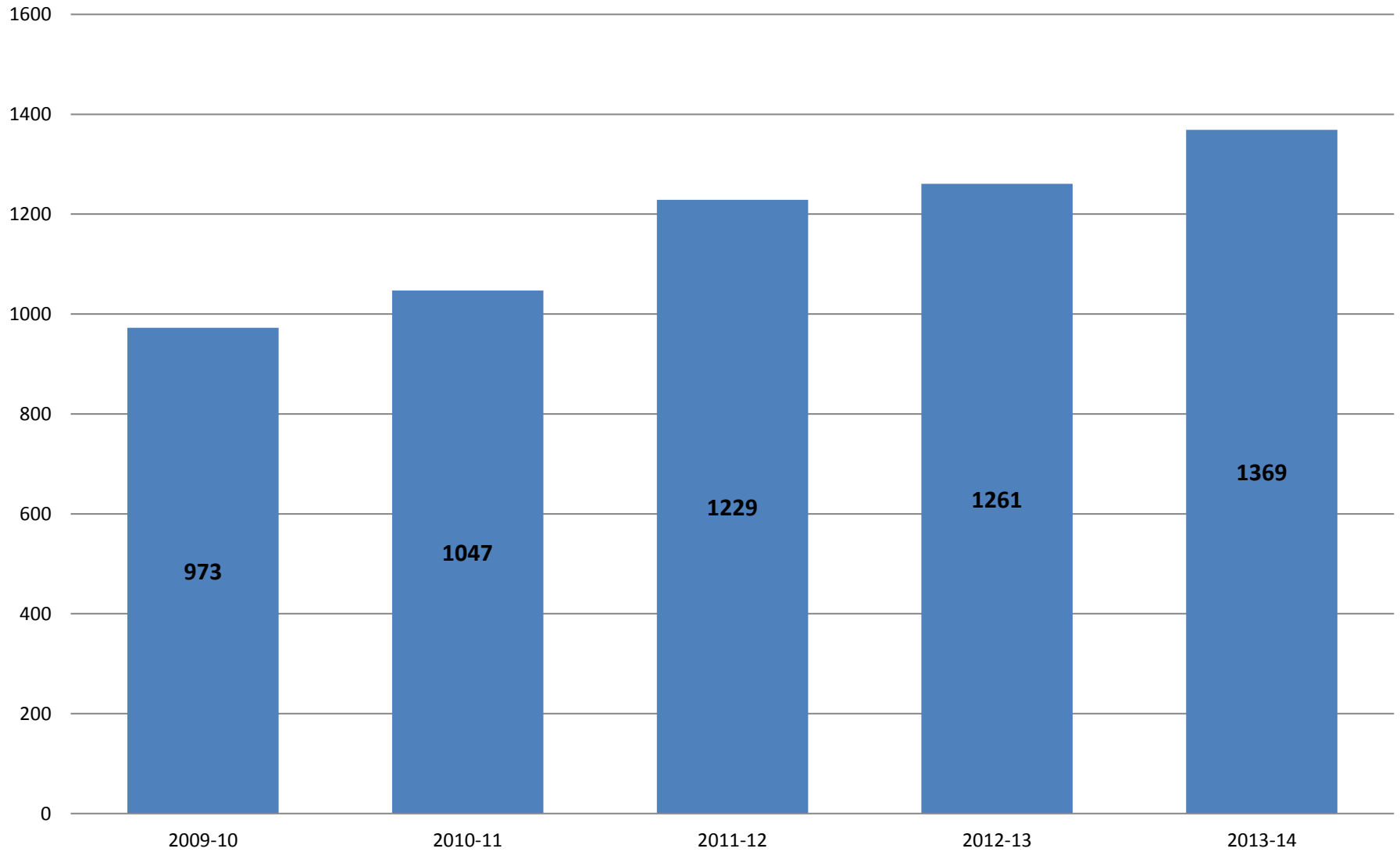
