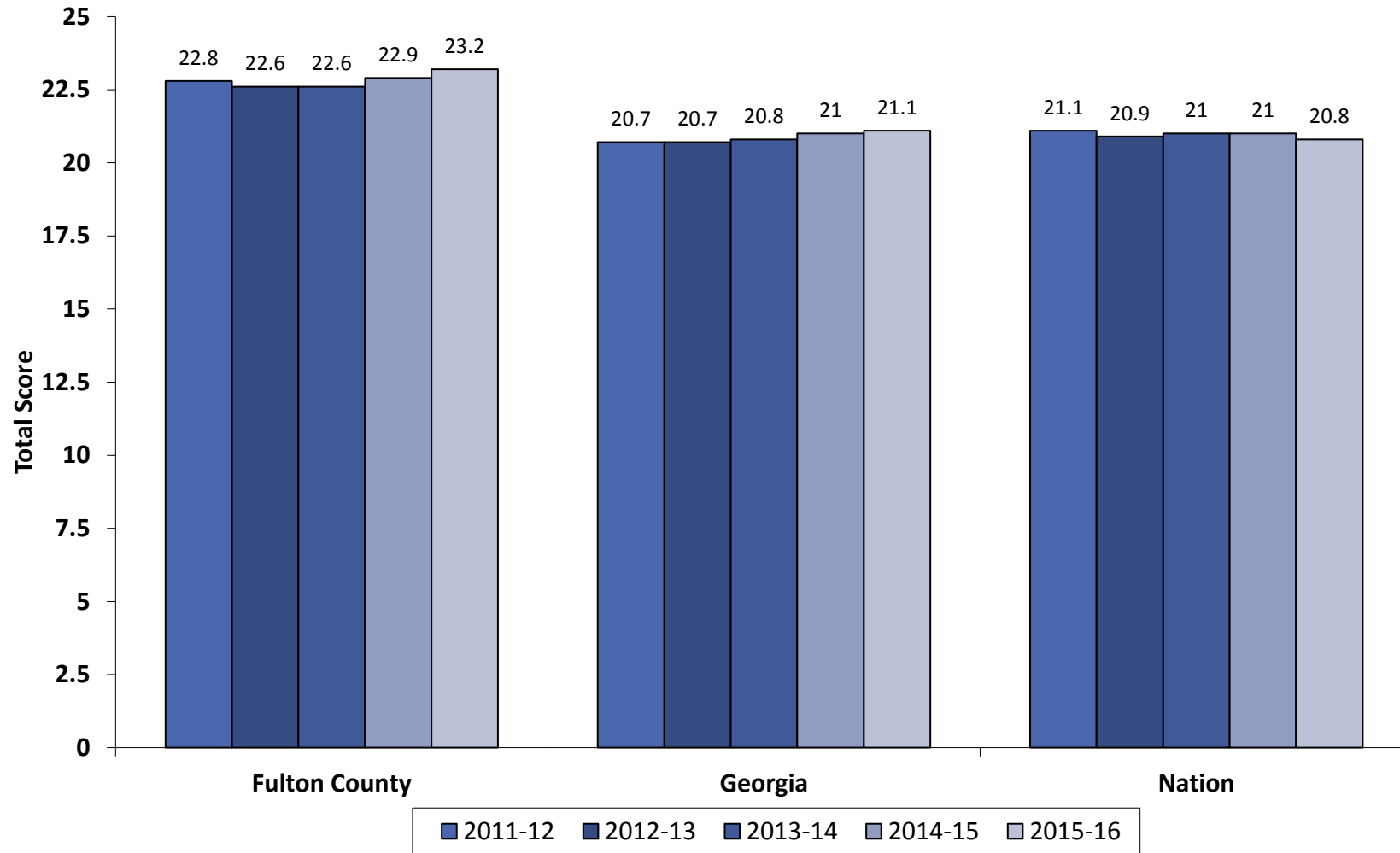
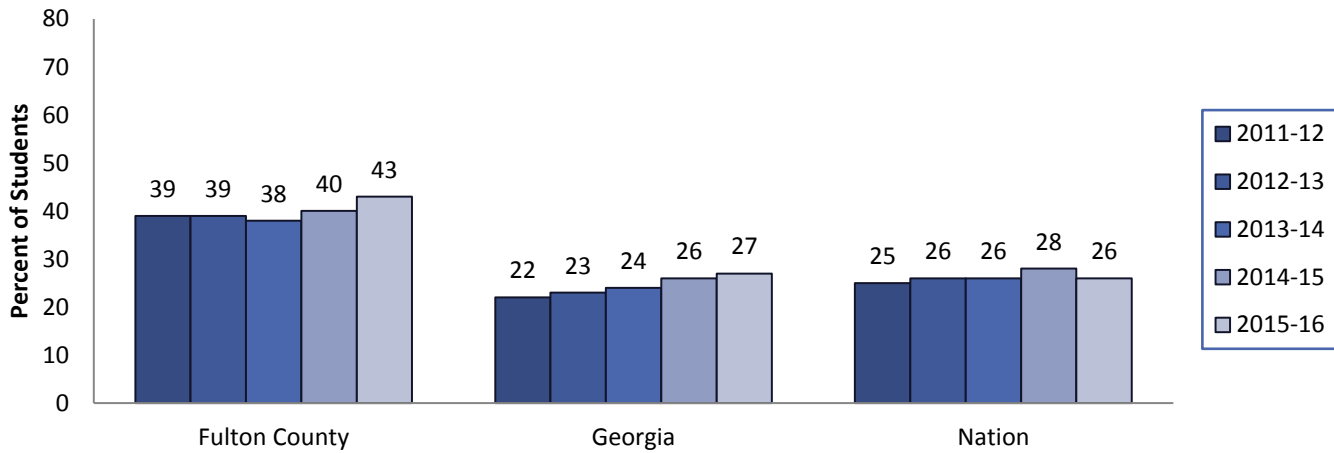


Fulton County Five Year Comparison Composite ACT Scores

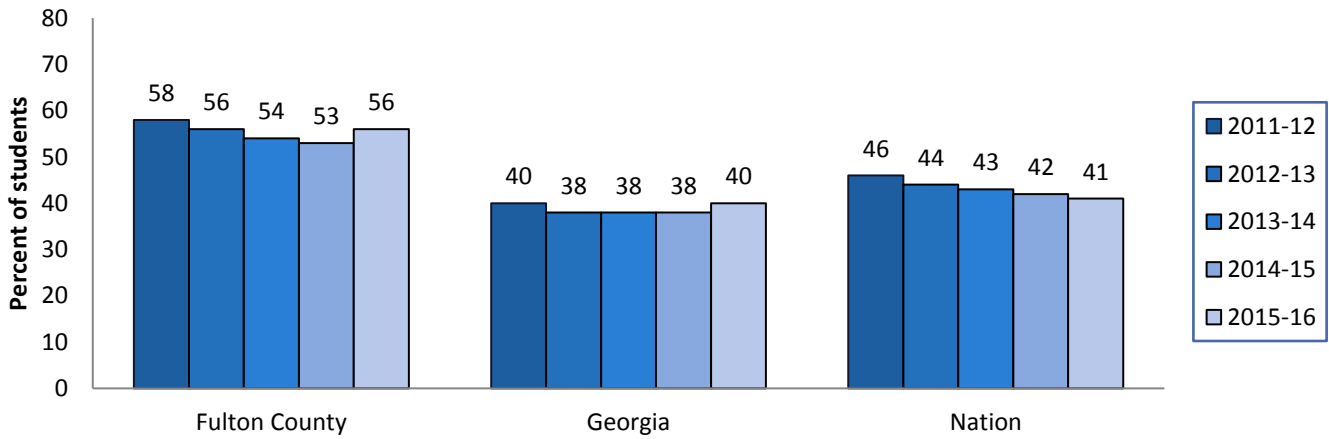


Fulton County Schools ACT College Readiness Benchmarks

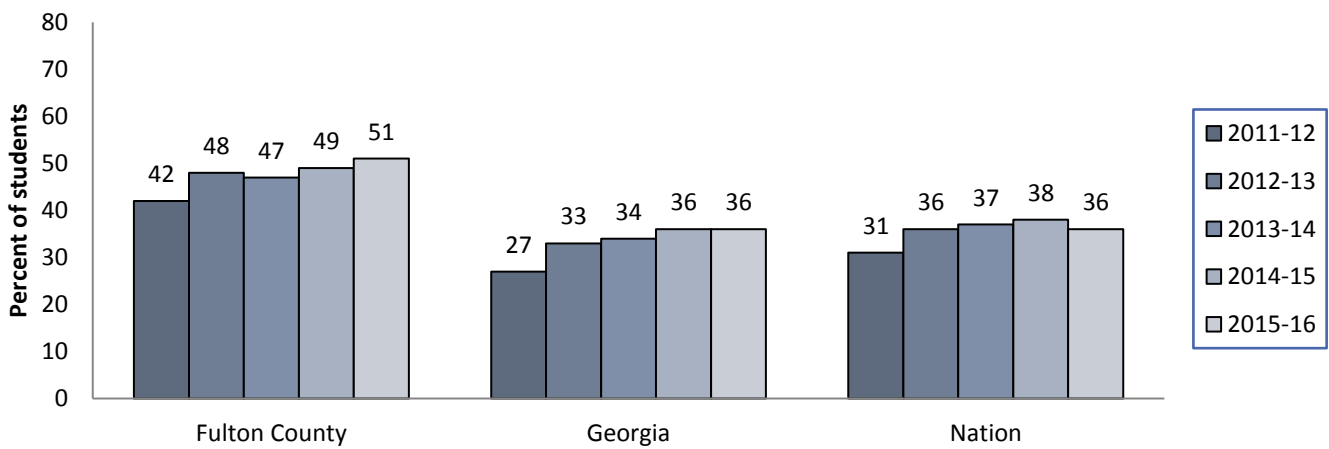
Percent Meeting All Four Benchmarks



Percent Meeting Mathematics Benchmark

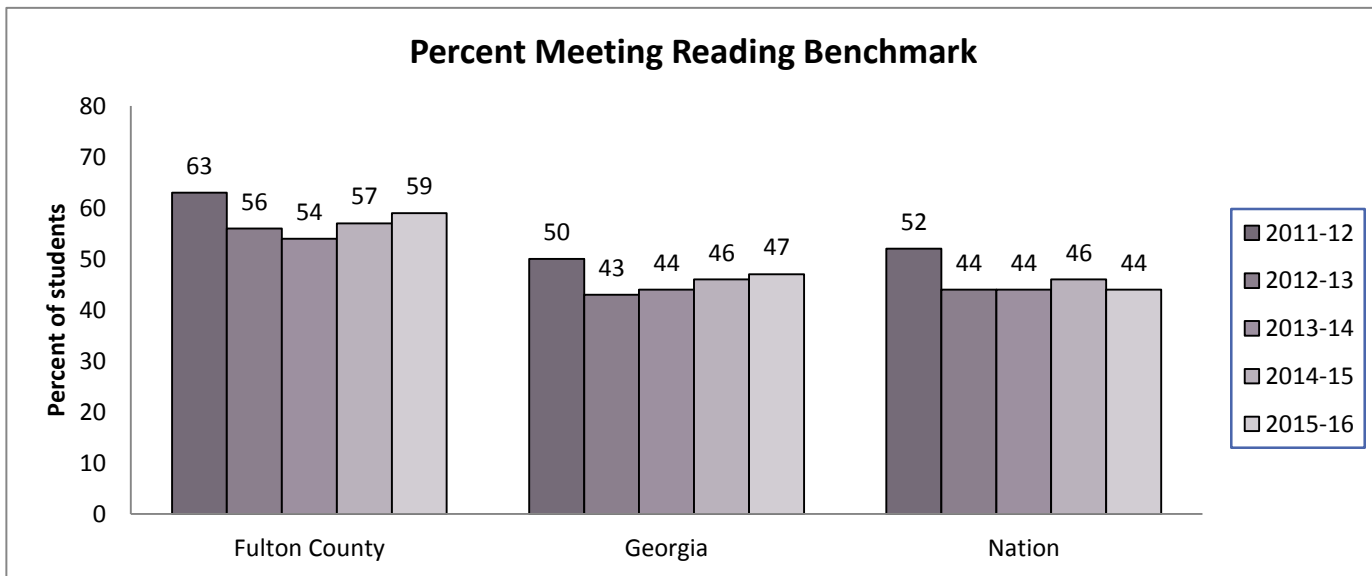
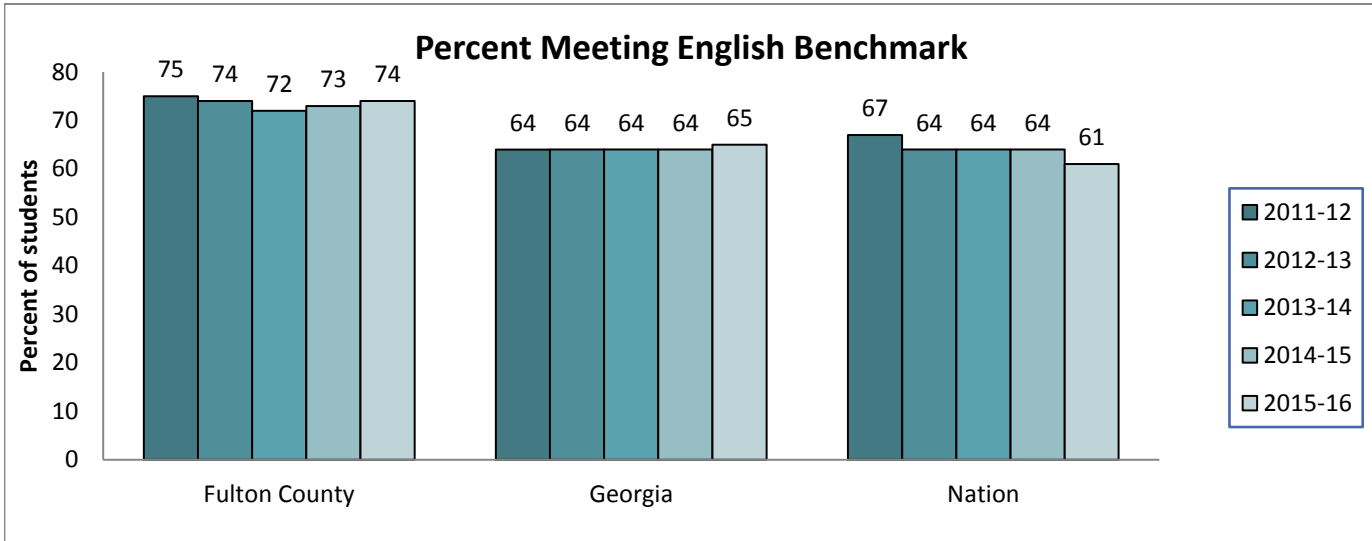


Percent Meeting Science Benchmark

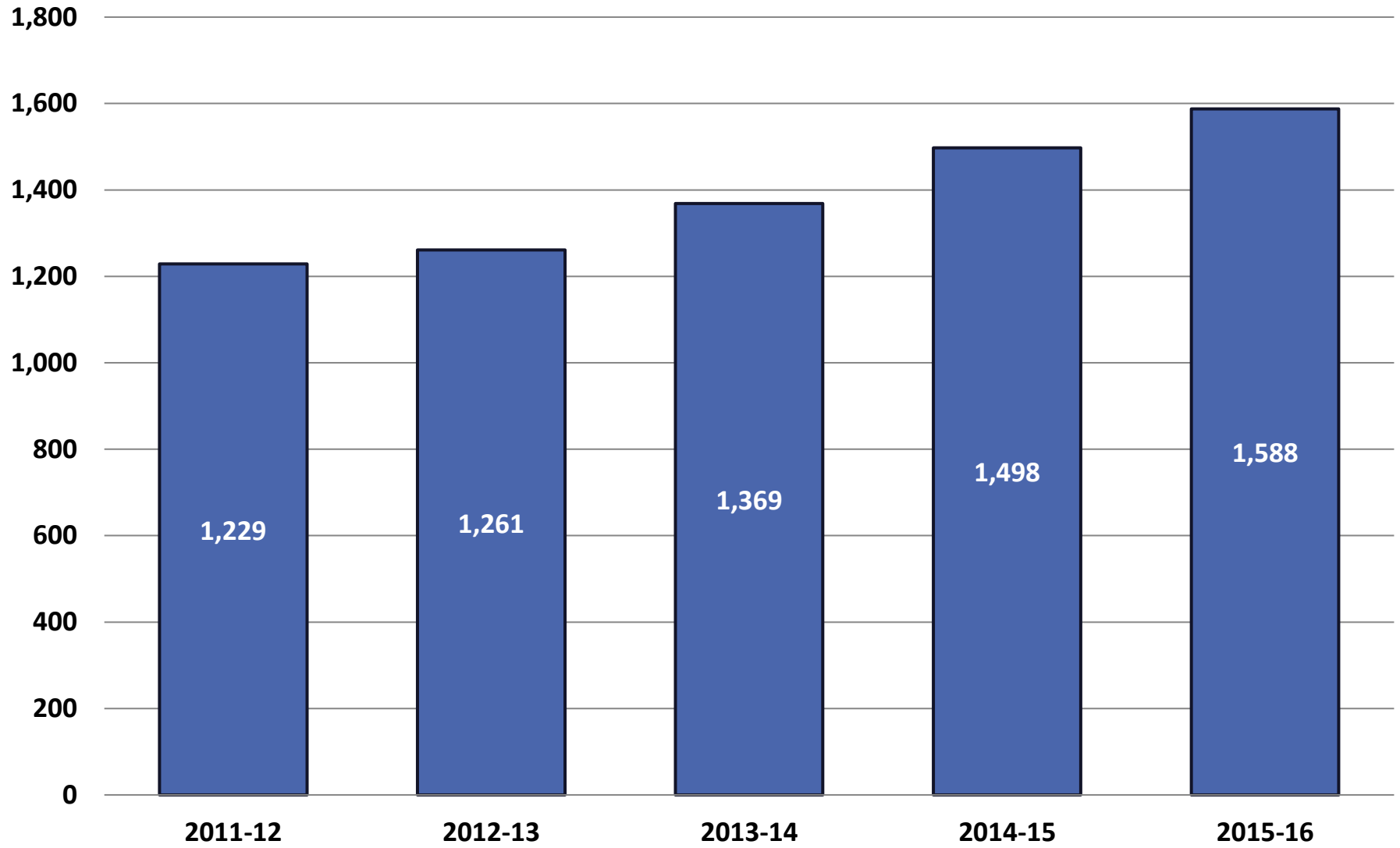
