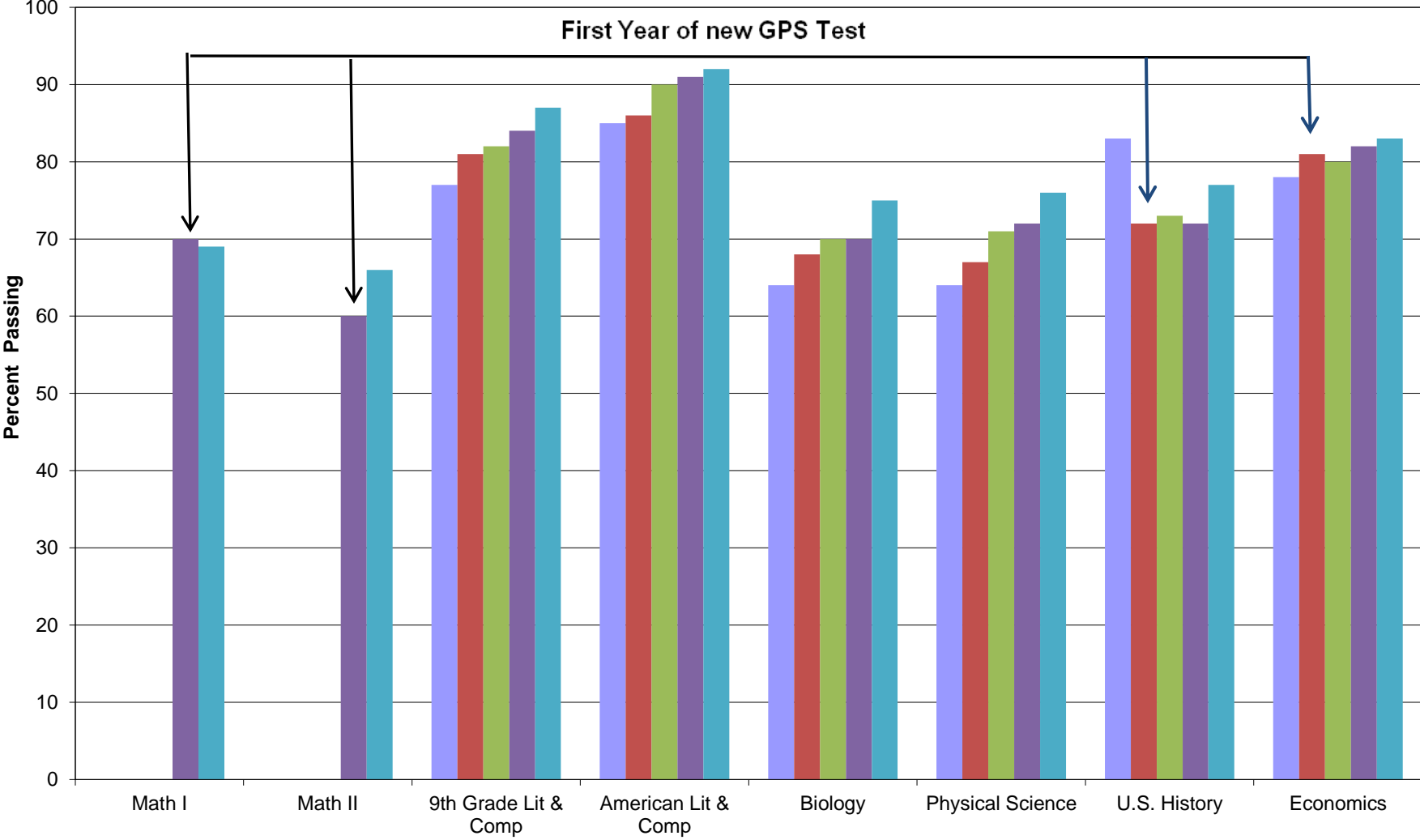


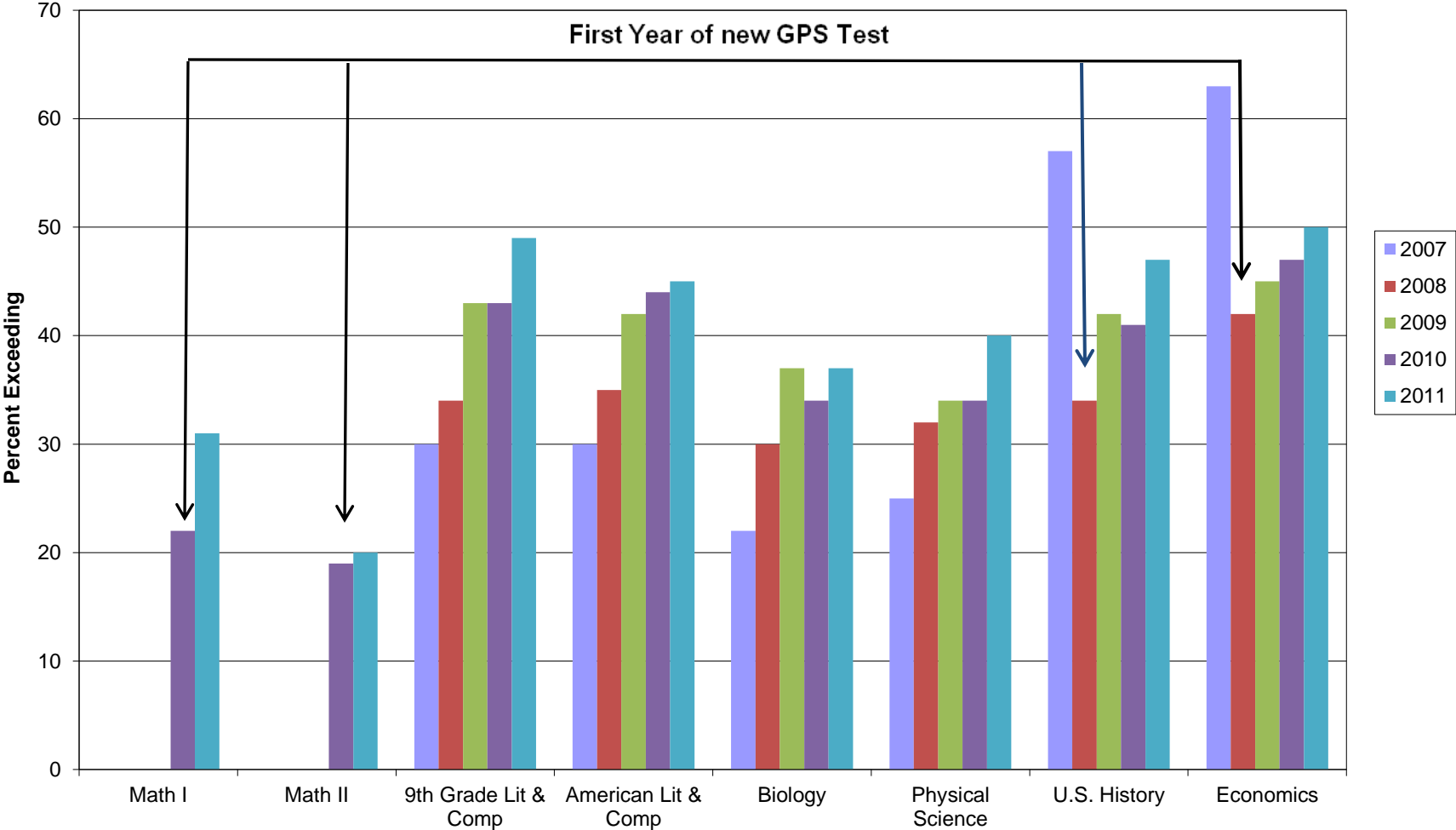
### Fulton County Schools EOCT Spring 2011 Results Percent Passing

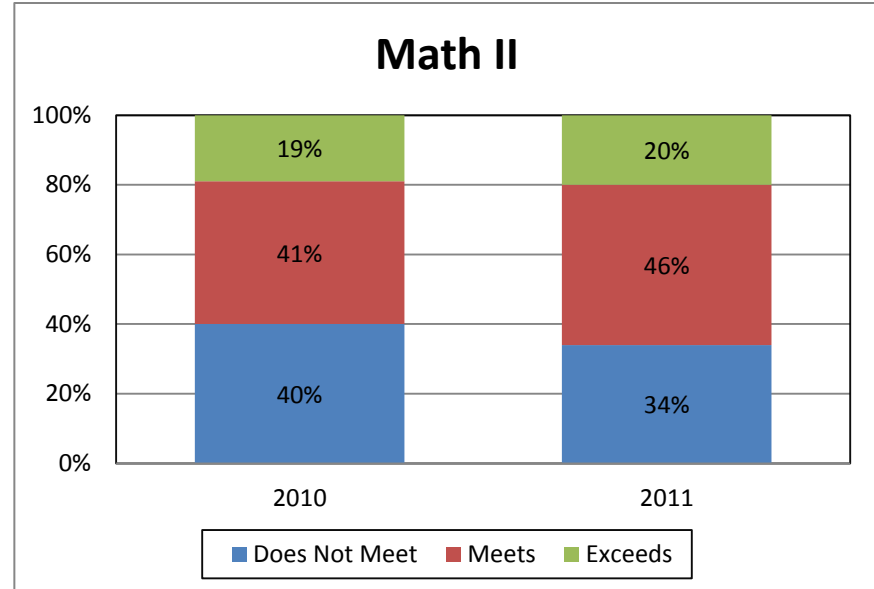
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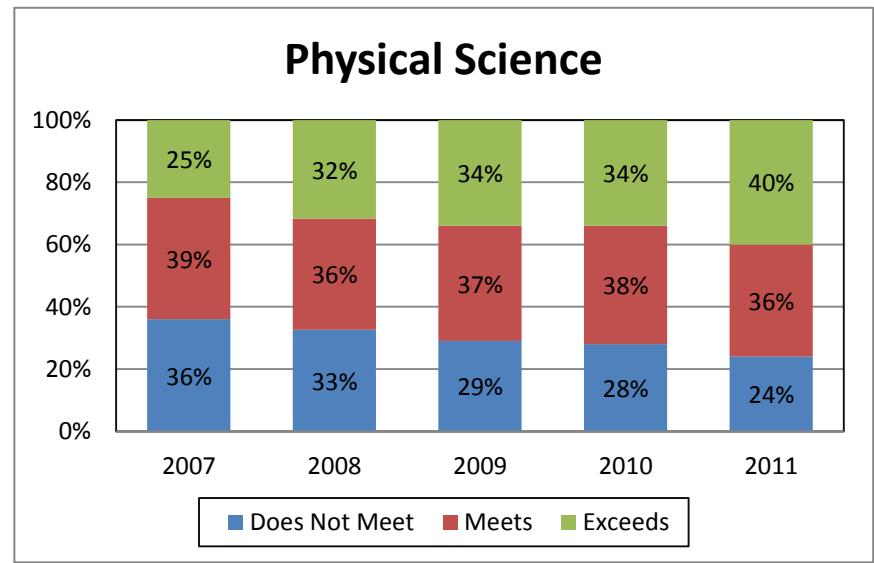
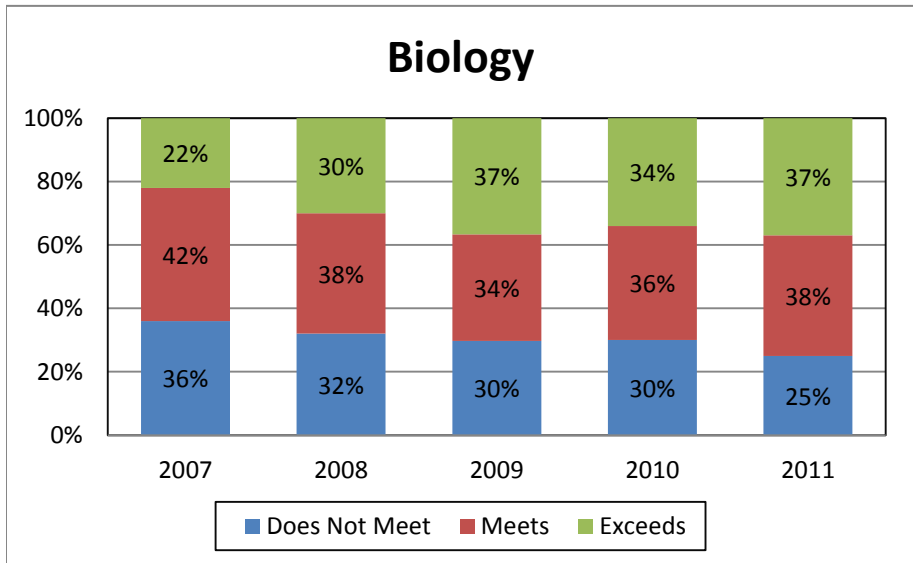
## Fulton County EOCT Content Area by Performance Levels



First year of Math I and Math II is 2010.

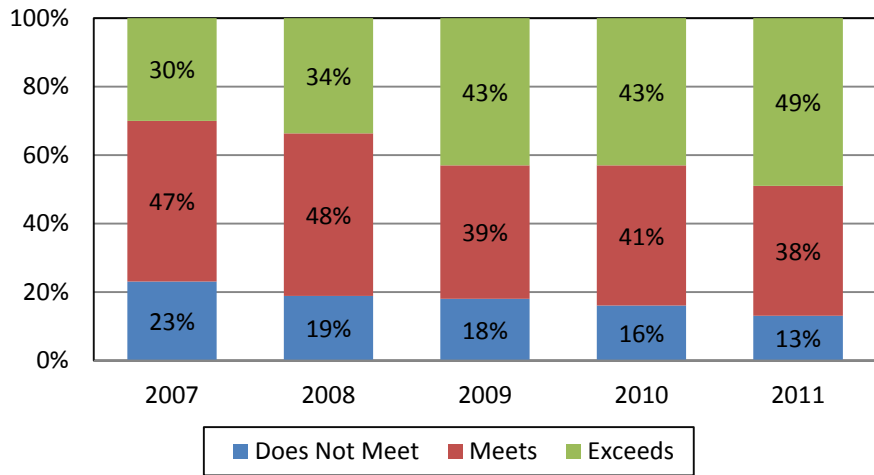

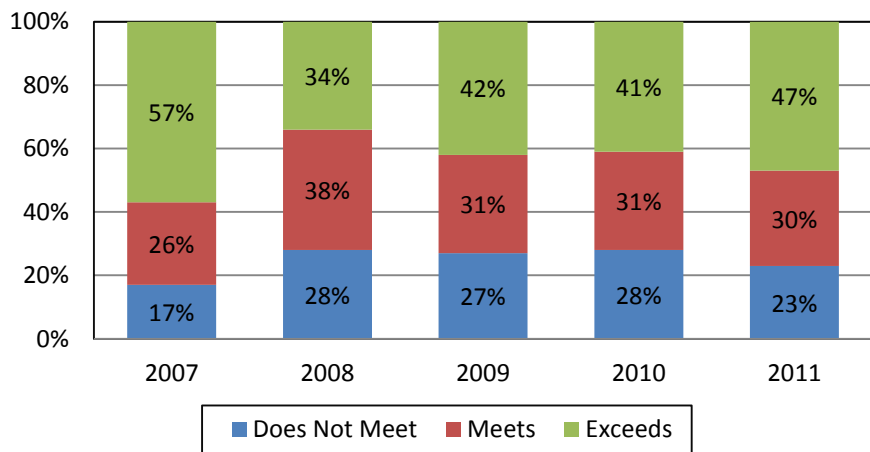

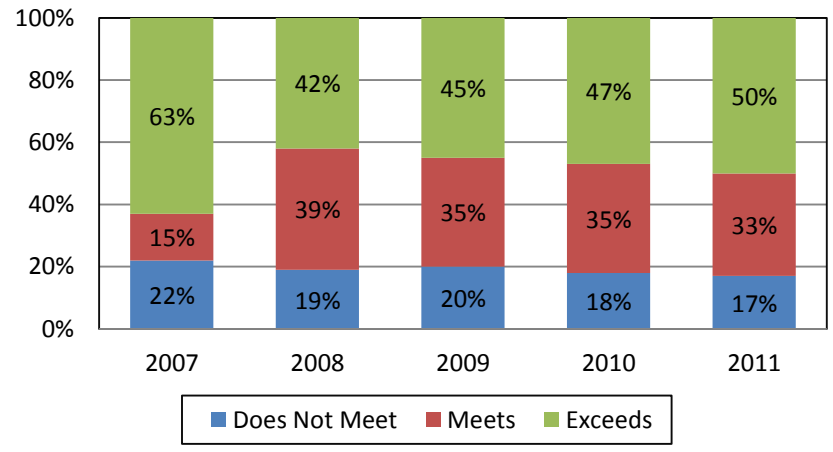
