

Transitioning Safely into Second Semester

With COVID-19 cases expected to increase due to travelling and family/larger group gatherings over the Winter Break, Fulton County Schools is focusing on a safe return for students and staff.

Employees

The transition plan occurs over two weeks, beginning with remote work days for all district staff on Jan. 4-5. Following that, school-based and central office staff return to their on-site work locations while teachers and paraprofessionals continue working remotely until Friday, Jan. 8.

Students

The first day of second semester is Jan. 6, and all students will engage in remote learning Jan. 6-8. The week of Jan. 11-15 will begin with middle and high school students only participating in remote learning while elementary students return for Face-to-Face instruction.

On Jan. 13, all students, PreK through Grade 12 (except those choosing Remote Learning for the second semester) will come back for Face-to-Face instruction. After that date, second semester will return to its regular schedule except in case-by-case situations.
