



## New Quarantine Guidance as of January 1, 2021

<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold;">1</p> <p>The quarantined individual must provide documentation of a <b>negative</b> (PCR or antigen) COVID-19 test result. The test must be taken on Day 5 or later with the results document <u>dated</u> on Day 5 or later of the quarantine</p>	+	<p style="font-size: 24pt; font-weight: bold;">2</p> <p>The quarantined individual must <b>not</b> have experienced <b>any</b> COVID-19 symptoms during the quarantine period</p>	=	<p>The quarantined period can be <b>reduced</b> to a minimum of <b>7 days</b></p> <p><i>Note that #1 and #2 must be met in order to be considered for a reduction in quarantine time. The day of exposure does not count as an actual quarantine day.</i></p>
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### Process

1. Parent or student makes a COVID-19 report via the [Parent \(Student\) COVID-19 Reporting Portal](#) (or) is contacted by Fulton County Schools/Fulton County Board of Health (FCS/FCBOH)
2. FCS/FCBOH determines the student has been exposed via direct contact to a COVID-19 positive person and is directed to quarantine for 10 days.
3. After receiving a negative test result (per above guidance), parent/student then reports and uploads the test results via the COVID-19 reporting portal.
4. FCS/FCBOH will review the uploaded test results and authorize the student's return to school after the 7th day of quarantine.
