McKinney- Vento law is the primary piece of federal legislation dealing with the education of children and youth experiencing homelessness in U.S. Public schools. It was reauthorized as Title X, Part C, of the No Child Left Behind Act in January 2002.

# Who are homeless children and youth?

Children and youth who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence, including children and youth who are:

### **Purpose**

Fulton County School's McKinney-Vento Homeless Program provides services to children and youth attending Fulton County Public Schools who are experiencing homelessness. The program ensures educational rights and protections for homeless children, including preschoolers and unaccompanied youth. The Program is governed by the McKinney-Vento Education Assistance Act as reauthorized in 2002.

- On the street
- -Sharing the housing of others due to eviction, loss of housing, or economic hardship
- -Living in emergency or transitional shelters
- -Living in motels or hotels due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations
- -Living in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, or any similar public or private setting not ordinarily used as regular sleeping accommodations for human beings
