

Summer Learning

2022-2023 School Year

Summer Learning is an opportunity for high school students to accelerate or recover credits during the time between school years. This includes students who receive services via an Individualized Education Plan (IEP). Face-to-face (F2F) and virtual offerings exist, and often provide students with a broader array of options than those available during the school year. The F2F summer session is a condensed version of content provided during the school year, and students must have their course requests validated by their counselor before being enrolled.

For Summer Learning 2023, students who have previously failed a course and/or failed an EOC tested course can retake the course for free through **Face-to-Face Summer Learning** or **Fulton Virtual**. Students may take up to two credits at no cost. Students who choose to accelerate through **Fulton Virtual** during the summer will require tuition.

Face-to-face Summer Learning courses will be offered for **special education students who require an adapted curriculum** (those assessed on the Georgia Alternate Assessment 2.0) that demonstrate learning loss. These students can choose to participate in face-to-face summer learning June 5 – July 3 at select summer learning sites. Special education transportation can be provided per the student's IEP and through the registration process.

If you have questions about summer learning, please contact your student's school counselor at his/her local high school. After May 25th, please contact the summer learning location serving your student's high school.

****Completion Benchmarks:** Students may work at their own pace but must make the required progress in their course by the benchmark dates. Students can work ahead and, if a student is on vacation, they will need to work ahead to remain on target. Students not reaching the completion benchmarks will be administratively dropped from their course. Dropped courses will not appear on transcripts and will not receive a refund of tuition paid. Completion benchmark dates are noted on the Important Dates chart.

Face-to-Face Summer Learning Courses

The following courses are available for students who need to retake a previously failed course and/or failed an EOC tested course:

- US History (US History B is an EOC course)
- Environmental Science
- Biology (Biology B is an EOC course)
- Algebra I (Algebra I is an EOC course)
- Geometry
- Algebra II
- Ninth Grade Lit/Comp
- Tenth Grade Lit/Comp
- Eleventh Grade Lit/Comp (American Lit B is an EOC course)

Tuition

1/2 Credit = \$225 (\$180 with free/reduced meal status) per course

1 Credit = \$450 (\$360 with free/reduced meal status) per course

*Students needing to retake a class may attend FCS summer learning through Face-to-Face Summer Learning and/or Fulton Virtual at no cost up to 2 credits. Additional credits/courses require tuition.


Transportation

Abbreviated transportation is available for summer learning. Please check the Transportation website after May 19th <https://www.fultonschools.org/site/default.aspx?DomainID=275> for bus stop and time information for your student. We will continue to use the Here Comes the Bus app during summer learning to ensure that you have the most up to date bus information for your student. If your student will require special education transportation per his/her IEP, please register no later than **April 26th** to ensure your student's route is in place for the first day of summer school.

Fulton Virtual (May 31 - July 12, 2023)



Fulton Virtual provides online learning options for middle and high school students throughout the district, enabling greater flexibility for students aiming to recover credit or accelerate classes. Fulton Virtual courses are teacher-led; instructors work with students, parents/guardians and other interested parties (e.g., counselors) to deliver course learning objectives and support the academic needs of each student.

The offerings of Fulton Virtual provide varied and dynamic content, user friendly customization and personalization options, as well as opportunities for students at earlier ages to engage in learning virtually.

Students can expect to spend 3 hours per day for each semester course taken in the summer term.

Fulton Virtual Online Registration

Parents and students request courses through the Fulton Virtual web page. Once a course request is created, an email is sent to the student's home school for review by the counseling staff. The review and approval process takes about two weeks. If it is approved, a follow-up email is sent to the parent/student confirming registration, and if applicable, requesting they log back in to fulton.geniussis.com to pay for their course(s).
