Pre-Kindergarten



For the first five days of TeleSchool, choose and complete one activity per day.

Provide a tray filled with textured material such as sand or shaving gel and encourage your child to practice writing familiar words and letters.	Go outside and find different sized rocks. Put them in order from smallest to largest. You can also talk about shape/texture/weight.	Put silverware away after it has been cleaned. Sort silverware by type and count the number of spoons and forks.
Have your child separate clothes into different groups, such as colors, light and dark, or socks and shirts.	Read to your child for 15 minutes.	Show your child a card with a number 0-9 on it. Have your child jump the number of the card. If your child can complete the activity successfully, try using numbers 10-20.
Read a favorite book. Draw a picture of the beginning, middle and end.	Predict how many hops it takes to get from one end of the hall/room to another. Then, check the prediction.	Give your child a piece of paper, have him/her choose a letter and write it at the top of the paper, walk around the house and see how many times your child can find the letter.
