

VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT:

FCSEPF PENSION BOARD MEMBER

The Fulton County Schools Employees' Pension Fund (FCSEPF) Pension Board is accepting letters of interest to fill an open voting member seat on the Pension Board. The Pension Board is comprised of seven (7) voting members and one nonvoting member who serves as a committee of the Fulton County Board of Education and assumes fiduciary responsibilities over the investments and operations of the Plan. The Board meets quarterly, generally on the second Thursday of August, November, February and May.

This role is an unpaid voluntary position. The individual will be designated by the Fulton County Board of Education to serve the remaining two years of a four-year term for a seat with term effective dates of June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2026.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Active or former school administrator
- Participant in the Fulton County Schools Employees' Pension Plan
- Must complete Continuing Education hours mandated by Official Code of Georgia Annotated §47-1-17 "Each public retirement system trustee shall complete appropriate education applicable to his or her fiduciary duties and obligations under the public retirement system."
- Must attend regularly scheduled Quarterly board meetings for FY2025 which will commence during the following months (subject to change with notice):
 - August 2024
 - November 2024
 - February 2025
 - May 2025
