

Crisis Assessment Information

If your child has been identified as a risk to their self or someone else, the Summit will provide a Crisis Assessment at no charge. Once the therapist has completed the assessment, you will be given a brief report that indicates your child's level of risk and contains treatment recommendations. If you would like the Summit to coordinate with the school, the therapist will also provide the report to the school counseling staff or social worker and follow up with them to ensure that your child gets the appropriate treatment.
