How were resources allocated to support your strategic plan?

Allocated SGC charter monies were funneled into the purchase of the River Eves STEM Lab teaching position, which is an element of the daily specials rotation. This position directly supports our Strategic Plan as we strive to hit the target of 70% of combined 3rd-5th grade students scoring at Levels 3 (Proficient) & 4 (Distinguished) in mathematics on the annual GA Milestones state-wide standardized assessment. The STEM Lab classroom integrates science, technology, engineering (via the "Engineering Design Model" - EDM) & *math* concepts. Higher-order mathematical thinking is methodically applied to learning exercises, which require students to consistently engage in collaboration to solve real-world/authentic problems and scenarios.

Outcomes

Literacy - 95% of students will be reading at or above grade level in 3rd grade by 2022 (Milestones Assessment).

Math - By 2022, 70% of all 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders will earn a proficient and distinguished score on Math Milestones.

Outcomes

Student Satisfaction - Increase the percentage of students who feel connected to River Eves.

Teacher Satisfaction - Increase the percentage of teachers who are satisfied with their experience at River Eves.

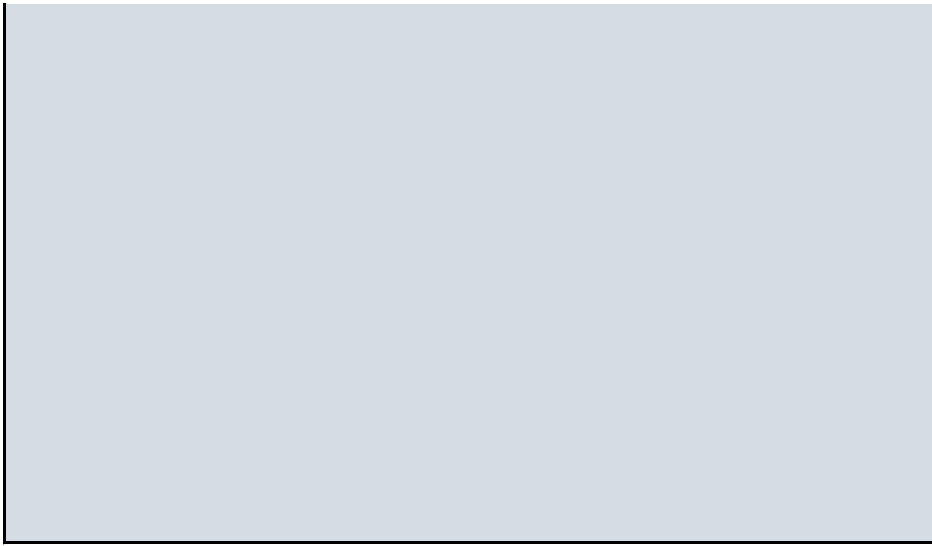
