

### **Hardship Window**

Applications for a hardship transfer are open and will remain open through Feb. 29. Applications are reviewed annually by the Student Assignment Office. Through this process, parents can seek a transfer for medical reasons, curriculum differences, child care situations or if they are an employee of the school system. Parents may also request the renewal of an existing hardship transfer. The <a href="Hardship Transfer Policy">Hardship Transfer Policy</a> as well as the <a href="Hardship Transfer Guidelines">Hardship Transfer Guidelines</a> will be used to determine student eligibility. Please remember that all staff who have children here on a hardship, MUST fill out this form annually to maintain enrollment.
