

2020-2021 Student Parking

(updated 9/10)

ELIGIBILITY

- Parking is assigned only to 11th and 12th graders. No parking will be given to 10th graders regardless of the number of credits.
- Students must have less than six (6) unexcused absences in the Spring 2020 semester.

1st ROUND APPLICATION/PICKUP

- The **1st round** of parking applications for the 2020-2021 school year was accepted from **April 20th to May 7th**. The list of those approved/waitlist students was posted on the CHS website on **Friday, May 8th**.
- **If on the approved/waitlist**, these students will be able to **pay online** for their permit starting **Thursday, September 10th**. The Online School Payments link on the CHS website will be available at that time. *****Please note: There will be no refunds for any reason. We will accept online payments only. DO NOT PAY UNLESS YOUR NAME IS ON THE APPROVED/WAITLIST. *****
- **If a student is on the approved/waitlist and has paid online**, students will be able to **pick up** their permit on **September 15th, 16th, and 17th from 10:30-1:30 in the bus loop**.

2nd ROUND APPLICATION/PICKUP

- The **2nd round** of parking applications will be accepted from **8:00 am on October 5th to 3:30 pm on October 9th**.
- If you have a **driver's license and a vehicle by October 14th**, complete the [2020-2021 Student Parking Application](#).
- If you will **receive your license/vehicle during the 2020-2021 school year**, complete the [2020-2021 Student Parking Waitlist Application](#).
- The list of **2nd round** approved/waitlist students will be posted outside the AP office and on the CHS website on **Wednesday, October 14th by 10:00 am** and those students will be able to pick up their permits beginning at that time. *****Please note: There will be no refunds for any reason. We will accept online payments only. DO NOT PAY UNLESS YOUR NAME IS ON THE APPROVED/WAITLIST. *****
- Unfortunately, due to limited parking spots, submitting the application does not guarantee a permit.

Students must bring the following in order to pick up their permit:

- Completed Fulton County Transportation Form (on the CHS website under **News and Announcements and Updated Parking Information**) [Fulton County Transportation Form](#)
- Driver's License
- Current Proof of Auto Insurance or Motor Vehicle Registration (check expiration date)
- Email or printed receipt for OSP payment of \$70 (online payments only)

Please note the following:

- Sophomores are not allowed to apply for parking for any reason.

- Participating in sporting/athletic/other activities does not guarantee you parking.
- Participating in Dual Enrollment, part time Virtual School or any other type of enrollment does not guarantee you parking. If you are not eligible for a parking permit, transportation is your responsibility.
- Skips to class (unexcused absences) or leaving campus without administrative or parent permission will result in a suspension or revocation of your parking privilege.
- Excessive tardies or absences to 1st period (or your scheduled arrival period if enrolled in Dual Enrollment or Virtual School) may result in a suspension of your parking privilege.
- Please note that meeting all the eligibility requirements still does not guarantee you parking if capacity is reached. If you apply and meet the requirements but we are at capacity, your name will be placed on a waitlist. Seniors on the waitlist get first priority.
