- Ideas, Beliefs, and Culture

## The AP Exam

- The AP U.S. History Exam consists of four parts, organized as follows:
- Section 1
- Part A: Multiple-choice questions (55 questions)
- Part B: Short-answer questions (3 questions)
- Section 2
- Part A: Document-based question (l question)
- Part B: Long response question (l question)


## Statistics a.bout AP US History

o Average Grade in Class = 83 (plus 7pts)
oAverage AP Score $=4.1$
o \% pass AP Score in typical Year $=90 \%+$
○ \% pass with a 4 or $5=75 \%+$
o Pages in Text Book read = about 1000
o Chapter Review sheets completed = 34
o Essays written = about 10-12 per year
o Major Projects = 2
