The Merchant Marine is the fleet of ships which carries imports and exports during peacetime and becomes a naval auxiliary during wartime to deliver troops and war materiel. The Coast Guard is a maritime, multi-mission service unique among the U.S. military branches for having a maritime law enforcement mission (with jurisdiction in both domestic and international waters) and a federal regulatory agency mission as part of its mission set. The strategic role of the US Navy is the projection of force into areas beyond a country's shores to protect sea-lanes, ferry troops, and to frustrate seaborne force by our enemies. Elite units such as the Navy Seals undertake high risk, multi-modal missions to protect our country. Our very own Stanley Derrico on our custodial staff served in the Navy.
