FIRST GRADE WEEKLY

Reading:

ELAGSE1RL3: Describe characters, settings, and major events in a story, using key details.

ELAGSE1RL2: Retell stories, including key details, and demonstrate understanding of their central message or lesson.

ELAGSE1RF3: Know and apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words.

Math:

MGSE1.OA.3 Apply properties of operations as strategies to add and subtract. To add $2 + 6 + 4$, the second two numbers can be added to make a ten, so $2 + 6 + 4 = 2 + 10 = 12$. (Associative property of addition.)

ADV Math:

MGSE1.NBT.6 Subtract multiples of 10 in the range 10-90 from multiples of 10 in the range 10-90 (positive or zero differences), using concrete models or drawings and strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction; relate the strategy to a written method and explain the reasoning used.

ACC Math:

MGSE2.MD.10 Draw a picture graph and a bar graph (with single-unit scale) to represent a data set with up to four categories.

ELA/Writing:

ELAGSE1W1: Write opinion pieces in which they introduce the topic or the name of the book they are writing about, state an opinion, supply a reason for the opinion, and provide some sense of closure.

ELAGSE1L2: Demonstrate command of the conventions of standard English capitalization, punctuation, and spelling when writing.

Science:


