For example:



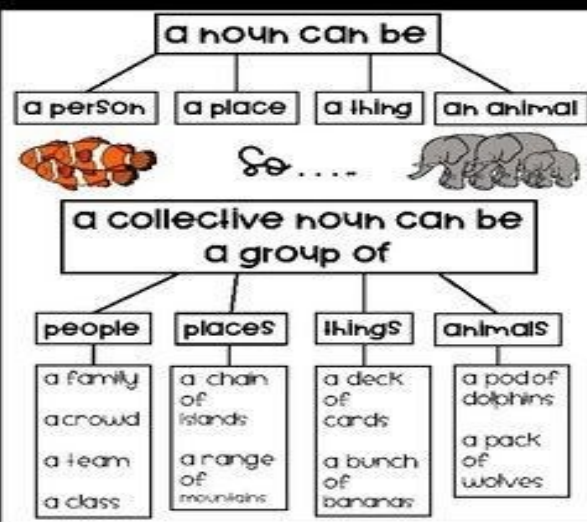
**Problem:**
