COMMAS

in Letter Greetings

Dear Uncle Tom,
 Dear Principal,
 Dear Mr. Smith,



A letter starts with a greeting. For the greeting, **capitalize** the first word and end with a **comma**. Make sure to capitalize **proper** nouns, such as Uncle Tom.

Math:

addition +

number sentence: $6 + 4 = 10$

draw a picture:

clue words: in all, add, join, both, total, plus, combine, altogether

number line:

10 fish in the pond. How many fish are left?

subtraction -

number sentence: $10 - 6 = 4$

draw a picture:

10 fish in the pond. How many fish are left?

clue words: subtract, minus, less than, fewer, decrease, separate, take away
