- District Parent and Family Engagement Plan

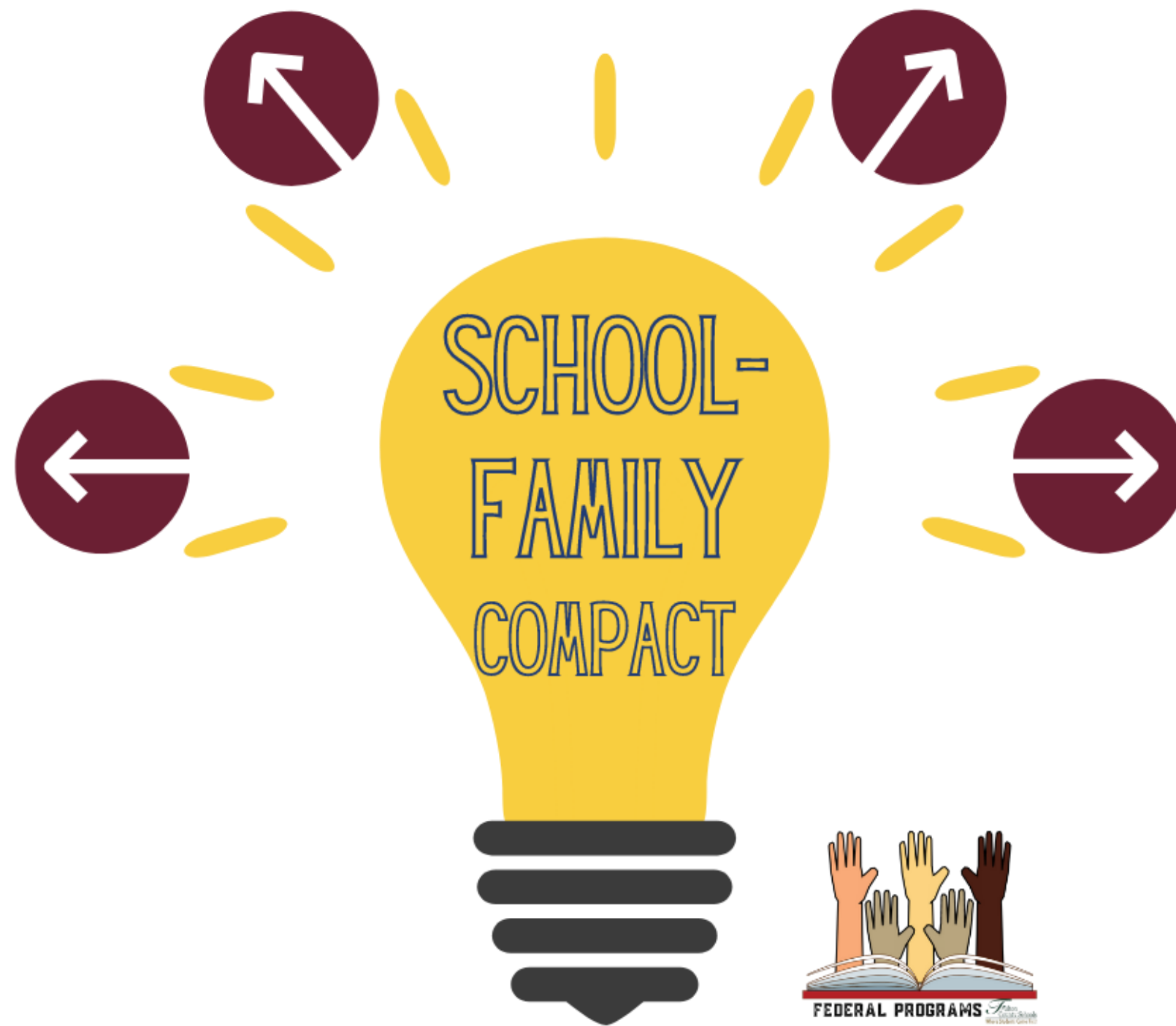

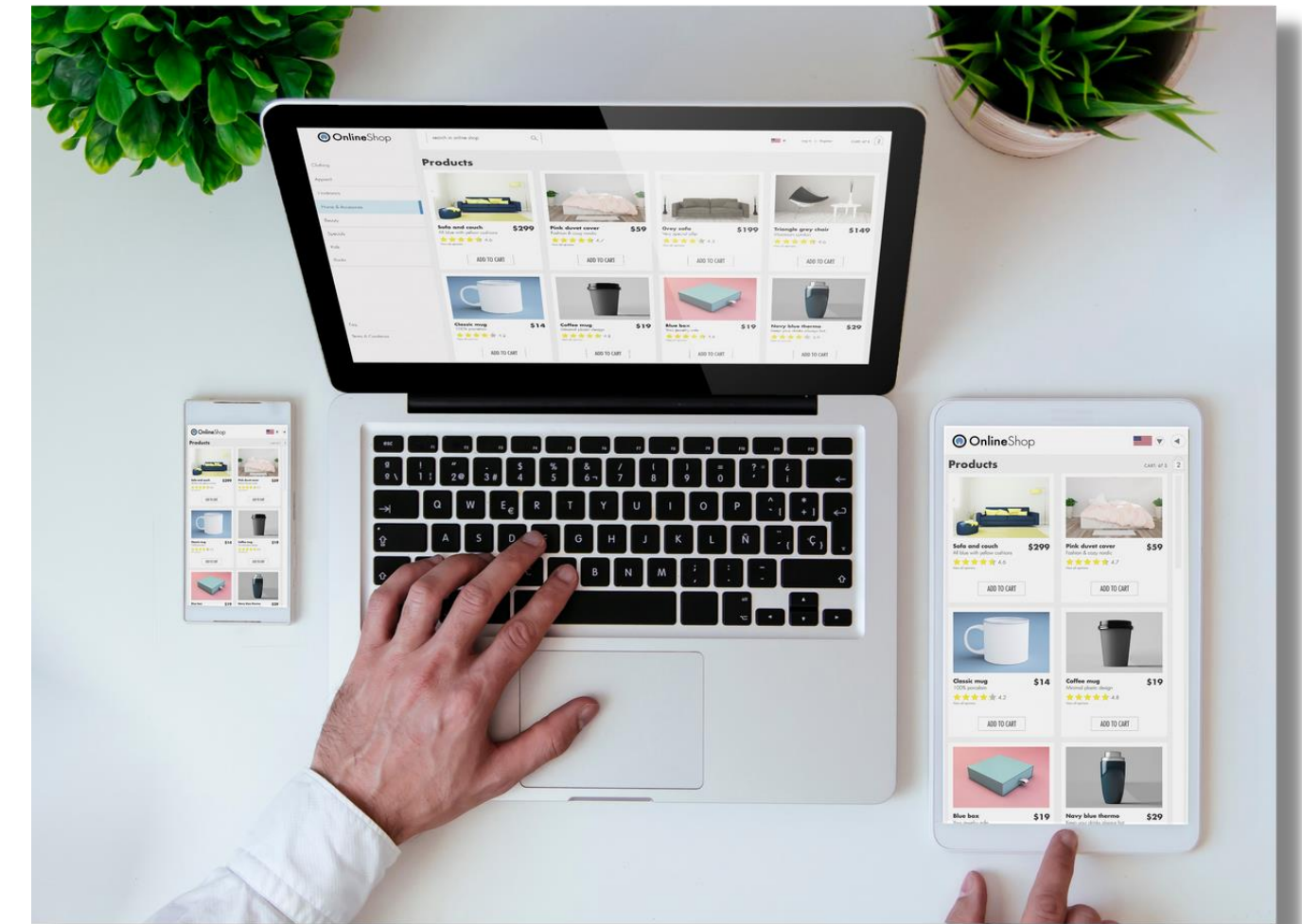

# Seaborn Lee Elementary's Academic Focus Areas



## Proposed 2023 - 2024 Academic Focus Areas

### ELA K-2:

- recognizing high-frequency words
- reading for fluency and comprehension
- applying phonetic skills and decoding

### Math K-2:

- computing basic math facts -solving multi-step word problems
- building fluency with addition and subtraction and develop an understanding of strategies within 100 – 1,000

### ELA 3-5:

- utilizing and monitoring vocabulary strategies to build fluency and comprehension
- demonstrating comprehension of literary and informational texts

### Math 3-5:

- computing and solving problems using all four mathematical operations
- building fluency with addition and subtraction and develop an understanding of strategies up to 1,000,000
- solving multi-step word problems using CUBES strategy

### ACADEMIC SUCCESS

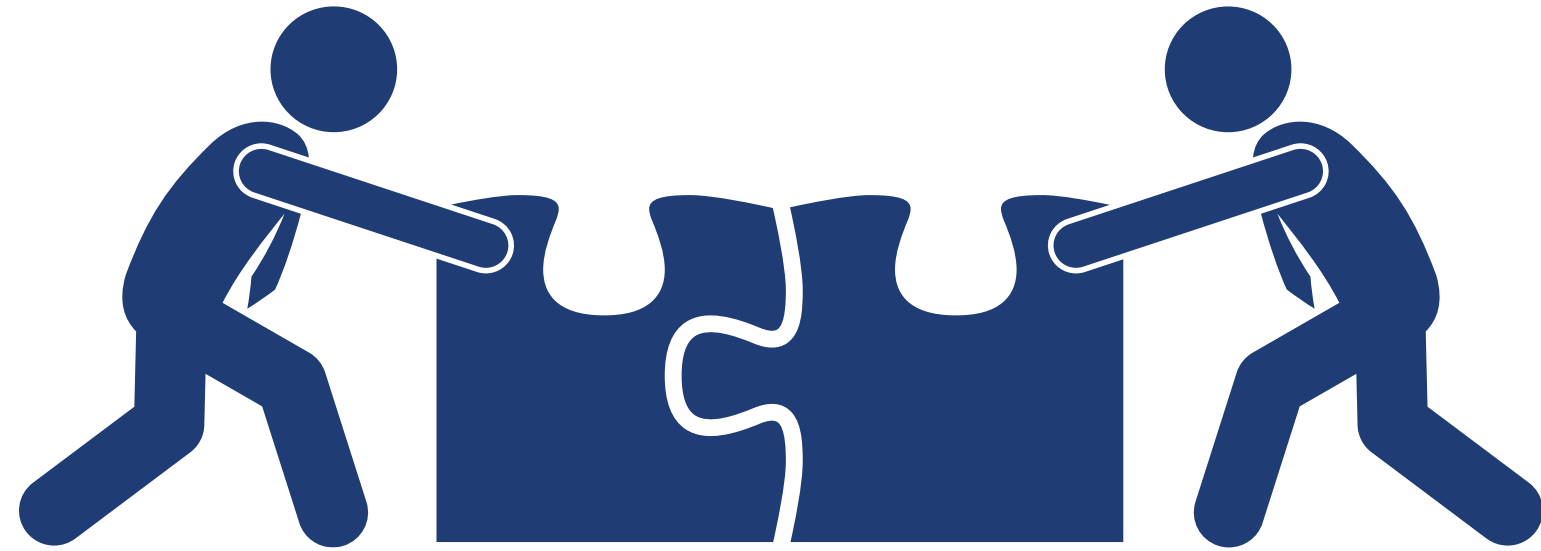

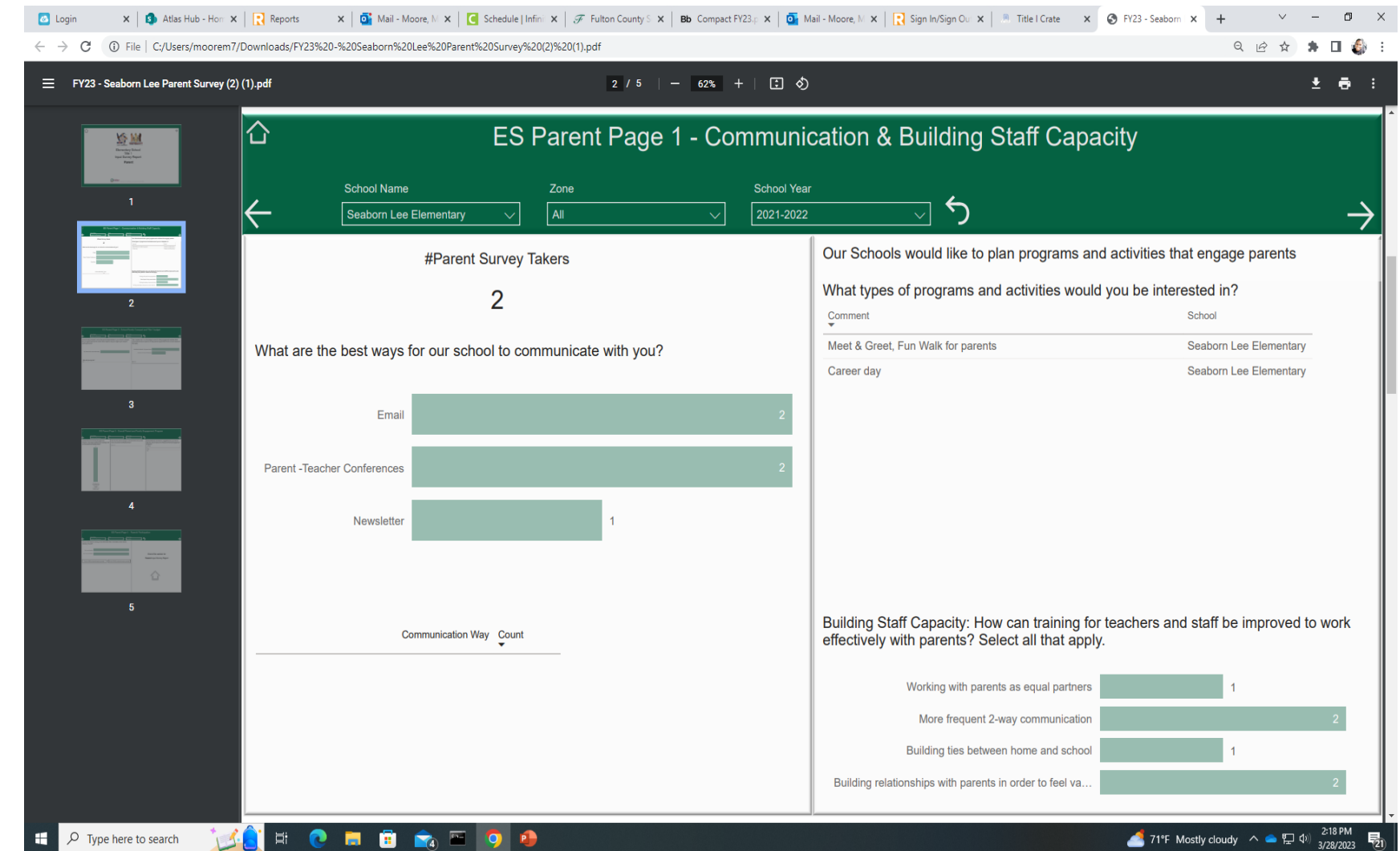

Title 1 Survey Dashboard

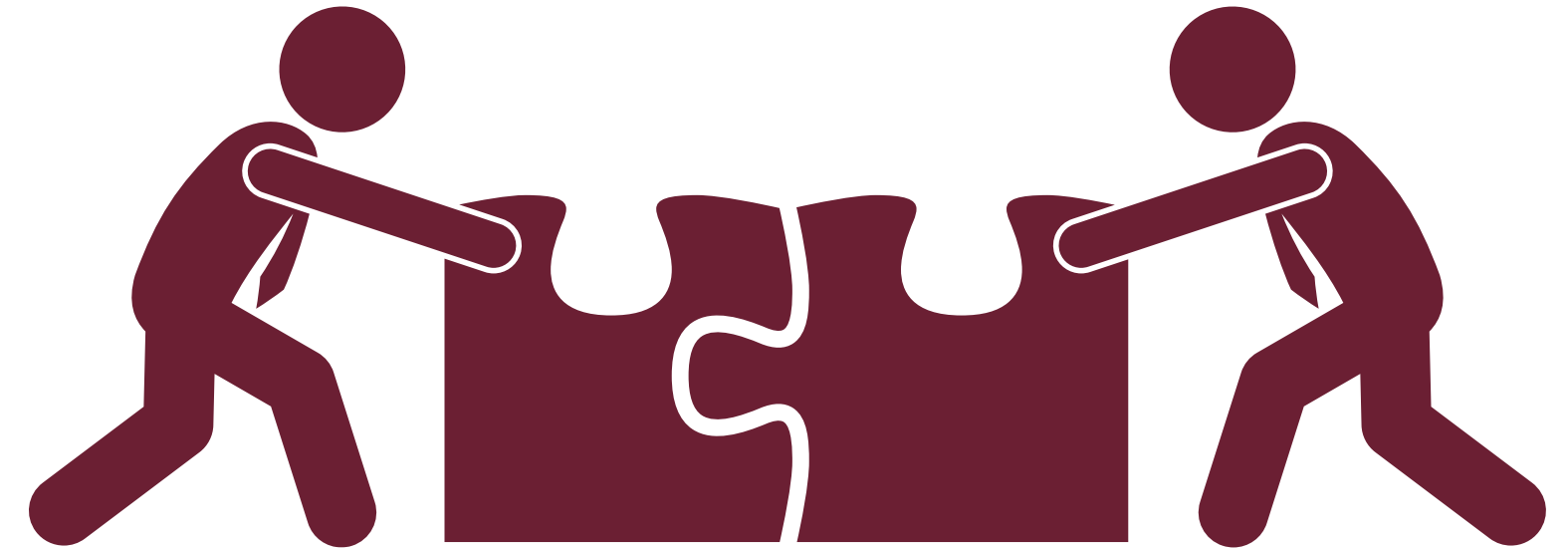
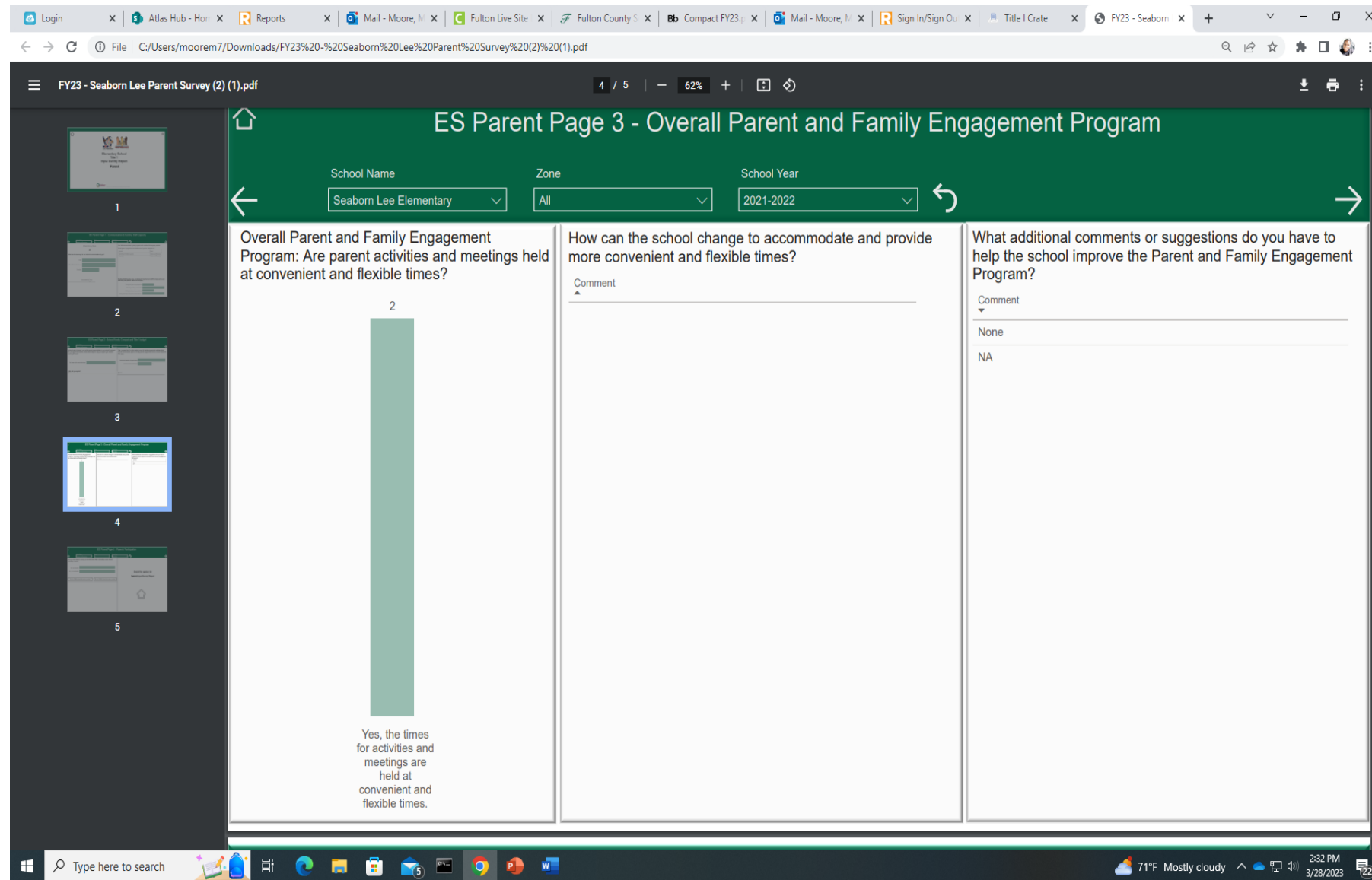

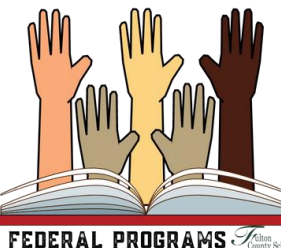
