Literacy Goals:

- 45% of K-2 students will score Tier I (Proficient) on the iReady Reading diagnostic by May 2021.

Math Goals:

- 40% of K-2 students will score Tier I (Proficient) on the iReady Math diagnostic by May 2021.

Focus Areas:

- Recognize high frequency sight words and decode nonsense words. Read for fluency and comprehension.

- Provide families with technology based resources such as iReady which supports reading comprehension and fluency.
- Provide online reading and math resources such as, Storylineonline.net, AdaptedMind.com and Prodigygame.com to help parents support their children at home.
