# REENTRY PLAN GENERAL INFORMATION

- • PreK-2 students may attend one day per week for 90 minutes.
- There are 2 90-minute sessions each day.
- All low incidence special education students may attend 1 day per week for 180 minutes and will be scheduled to start during the 1st session of the day to minimize impact on special ed services. (program classes only)
- F2F sessions will be offered four days a week.
- No F2F on Wednesdays for food distribution.
- PreK-2 students from the same household will attend on the same day and session.

## REENTRY PLAN GENERAL INFORMATION

F2F group sizes will be limited to no more than four (4) students.

Transportation will be provided by FCS bus or by parent drop off/pick up.

Bus transportation schedules will be published on 8/31/2020 for only routes already determined.

Face coverings will be required of employees and students.

Snacks will be provided. We will not serve breakfast or lunch.

Employees will perform health self-checks daily per FCS protocols.

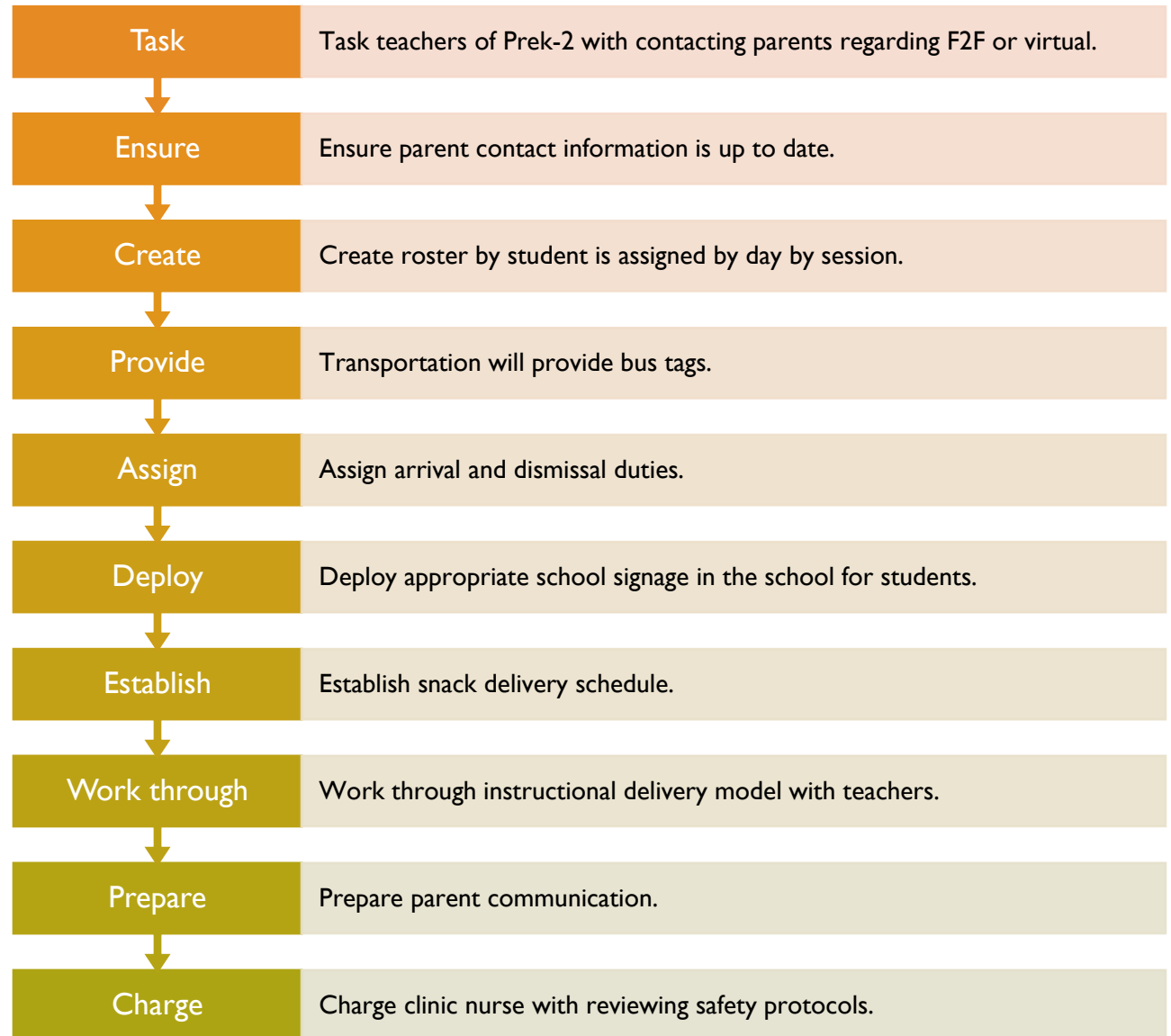
All families are requested to check the temperature of their child each day prior to leaving their home for school.

# ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Session 1

- Doors open at 7:20 AM
- Instruction 7:40 – 9:10 AM
- Dismissal begins at 9:10 AM

- Session 2

- Doors open at 10:20 AM
- Instruction 10:40 AM – 12:10 PM
- Dismissal begins at 12:10 PM

- Dismissal will be by intercom.
- Teachers will walk bus riders and walkers to the front lobby as called.
- Car riders will be directed by staff.



# MITIGATION MEASURES

## WATER FOUNTAINS

- In classrooms and the hallways, the fountains may NOT be used for drinking.
- Fountains may only be used to refill water bottles students bring from home. We have a limited number of water bottles for students.
