High School Paperwork:

1. **___ View the DE PowerPoint posted on <https://www.fultonschools.org/Page/21663>**
2. **___ Schedule a meeting with your school counselor two weeks before the deadline**
3. **___ Complete the FCS DE Contract and Advisement Form and submit it to your school counselor**
4. **___ Make sure you list the DE classes on your course verification based on the classes on your Advisement Form**

College Paperwork:

5. **___ Complete the admission application for the college(s) you plan to attend**
 6. **___ Send transcripts through www.gafutures.org to the college(s) you are applying**
 7. ___ Send official SAT/ACT scores or schedule to take the Accuplacer at GSU or GTC by the college deadline (check if colleges are requiring test scores for admission)
- *Students applying to a Technical College can use their 10th grade PSAT scores as their entrance exam.
8. ___ AP test scores must be requested online from www.collegeboard.org
 9. ___ Complete your Funding Application at GaFutures.org. Directions posted on <https://www.fultonschools.org/Page/21663> and www.gafutures.org
 10. ___ Use your personal email to apply to college. Check your personal and college email/admissions account and submit any additional documents required by the college (residency, immunizations etc.)
 11. ___ Submit proof of acceptance to your counselor by the last of the semester to avoid placement in high school class
 12. ___ Attend college orientation and register for classes
 13. ___ Send a copy of your college schedule to your counselor by the first day of the high school semester
