## Applications

When are application deadlines? Early decision (non-binding): No Early Decision at UMichigan. Early Action (non-binding) deadline is November 1st with a guaranteed decision by January 31st. Regular Decision deadline is February 1st with a decision released by early-April.

Is an essay required for all decision options? Essays are required for all applicants, no matter the decision deadline choice.

Are letters of Recommendation required or suggested? Required--1 letter from an academic teacher.

Is an in-person interview required or suggested? We do not interview at UMichigan.

What does the school look for in each "round" of decisions? Students who are academically excellent, highly talented and broadly diverse.

Does the school use the Common App? Yes!

How many applicants are received per year? Last year, we received 81,000.

How much is the application fee? \$75.00, but fee waivers are available and can be requested through the application.

Are there quotas for applicant acceptance? Never.

## Campus Life

Do freshmen live on campus? Yes, 97% do. All first years are guaranteed housing, but not required to live on campus.
